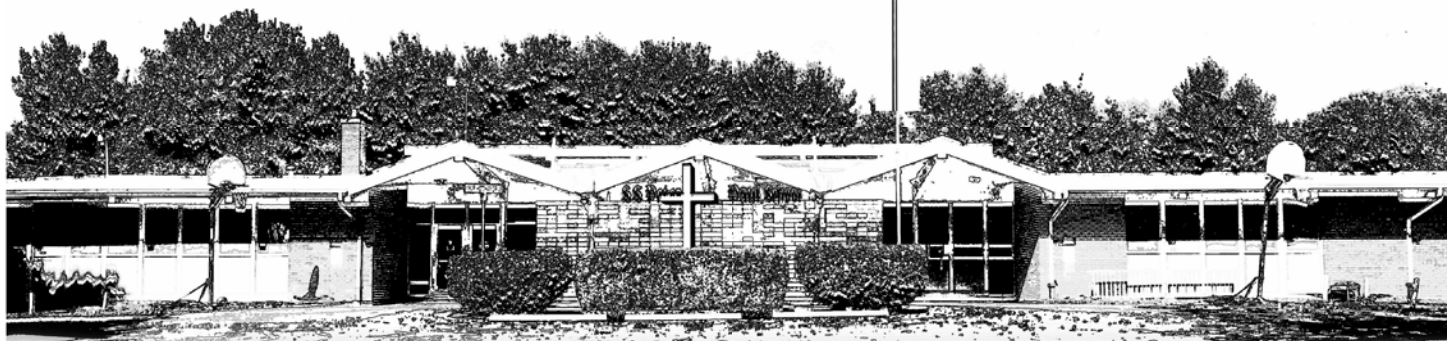

**From Fr. Tony:** Over the next several weeks, here's what's on the horizon: finishing the total emptying of our beloved churches designated no longer in use; helping All Saints Church and St. Vincent School in Keokuk with some of the items from our churches; setting up for Friday morning Mass at SPPS and Sunday Mass at Nauvoo K of C's; setting up Nauvoo CCD at the Villa Marie Rectory, and Warsaw CCD at the Bott Center; beginning Holy Archangels Parish Finance and Pastoral Councils; hosting a Vicariate Priest luncheon and conference; and it looks like I'll need to be on Retreat in early October (diocesan priesthood requirement that I've passed on for a number of years now). In the midst of this, when there is need for the priest of this parish - me! - please don't react to this announcement with, "I don't want to bother you, Father; I know you're busy." Instead, try this: "I need contact with you, Father; so, if you don't respond right away, I'm going to keep on trying to contact you." I welcome the reminders!

## What we're watching on FORMED: Pier Giorgio Frassati: If I Didn't Have Love:

This movie depicts Pier Giorgio Frassati's life. Pier was just canonized on September 7. Frassati was a handsome, athletic and fun-loving young man from a rich, aristocratic Italian family who turned from a life of privilege to one devoted to working with the poor, suffering and homeless, and was a courageous witness of Christian faith and charity to many others. Watch this one with a parent, there are some mature themes.

**Masses at Alleman Council K of C Hall:** The Time Has Arrived for SPPN Church Site. Work on Wells Street, preserving street parking and working on curb repair, will begin on Wednesday, September 17. *Therefore: Friday morning Mass on September 19 with SPPS present will take place at the school gym; and Sunday morning Mass on September 21 will take place at Alleman Council K of C's in downtown Nauvoo.* This arrangement is going to last for a few weeks. We have assurances that adjustments to accommodate funerals at SPPN can be arranged, should we have to schedule them. We ask from you what you have always given, in anticipation of this temporary change in location: your patience, and consideration of each other. The parking places by the back door of the K of C Hall should be reserved for people with difficulties in mobility. *Please make it a point to stay around awhile, after the September 21 Mass. Coffee and other drinks, donuts, and breakfast pizza will be offered for all who remain for some time together before we go our separate ways.* Let's see how all this goes!!

**Holy Archangels First Annual Parish Picnic** will be held on **Sunday, September 28, 2025, from 12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.** at **The Purple Park** located at N Co Rd 700 in Nauvoo (Northeast edge of town). Due to the Wells Street closure, Mass will be at the K of C Hall at 10:00 a.m. so food items may be stored in the refrigerators or kept warm at the hall as needed.
