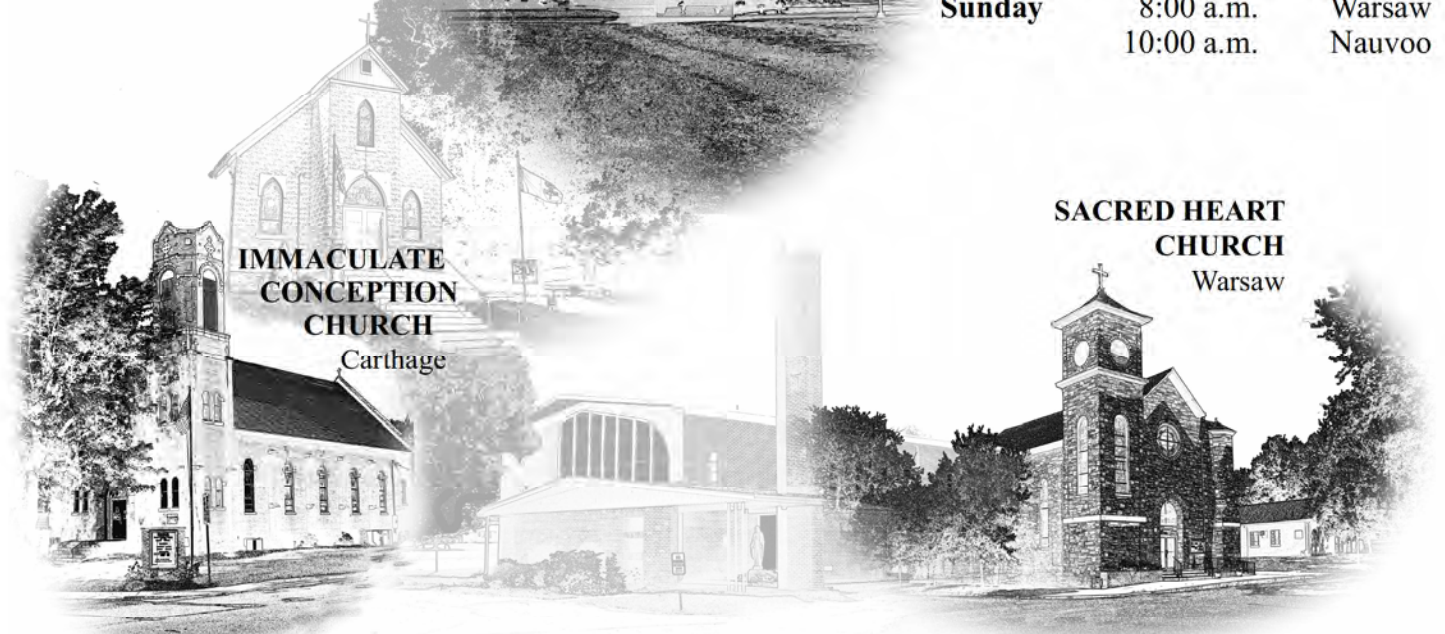

Many Latino people do not come to our Masses because they are unfamiliar with the English language, and thus feel awkward being around English speaking people - and those of us who speak English face the same lack of familiarity and awkwardness. So, here's the offer! We have bilingual missalettes at our IC Church Site of Holy Archangels Parish. We're looking for those English speaking parishioners who would be willing to "team up" with Latino individuals or families, sit next to them in Church during Mass, and guide them through the missalette. Turning to the appropriate pages...pointing out the Spanish text matching the English text...making connections on a level deeper than language...and seeing to it that you keep sitting together, week by week, as we get more comfortable with each other.
