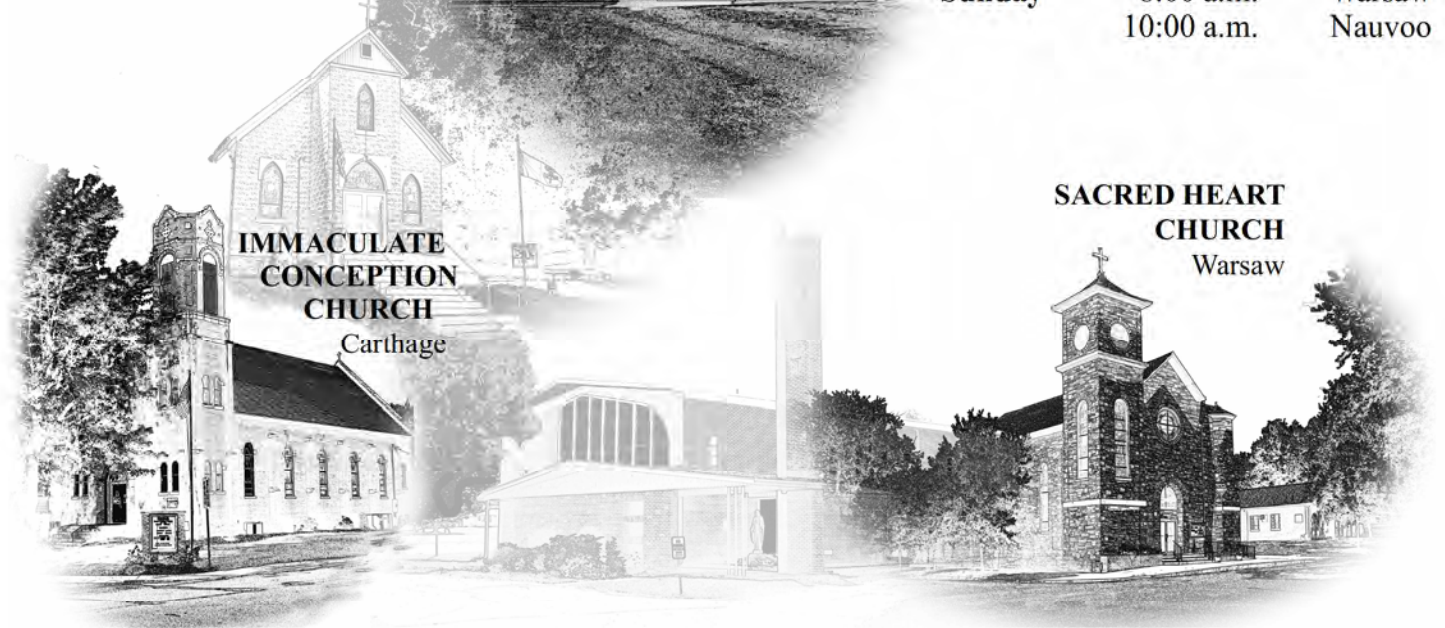

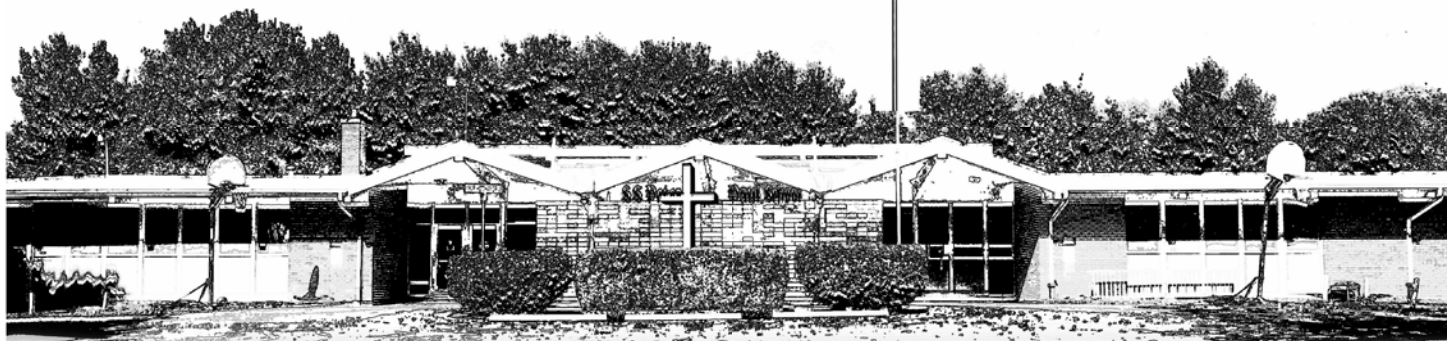

**Youth Group Pro Life Outdoor Service This Sunday, October 5, 7 p.m.** On behalf of Holy Archangels Parish, I have sent condolences and the offering of prayer to the competent authority of the LDS Community of Faith in Nauvoo, in Grand Blanc, Michigan, and in Salt Lake City. I've decided to hold an outdoor candlelight service at the Pro Life Monument in front of the Immaculate Conception Church site, with an invitation extended to LDS members in our area, so that we can pray for those who lost their lives at Grand Blanc, Michigan, along with all the other acts of violence having taken place in recent weeks. ***We hope you attend, and if you do, come with your candle. Take care to have a candle you can hold securely.*** Our Courageous Hearts Youth Group will assist in leading us through the service of prayer and worship, which should last half an hour.
