Did You Know You Already Have Two Feast Days Waiting for You? You're on the Calendar of Saints in the Catholic Liturgy of the Eucharist, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass! Just a' waitin' for you to get there! All Saints Day, November 1, is our recognition, veneration, love, and honor offered through the Cross and Resurrection of Jesus for the gift of those among the cloud of witnesses surrounding the heavenly throne, among whom are those whom we loved and with whom we lived and worked. All Souls Day, November 2, is our recognition, veneration, love, and honor offered through the Cross and Resurrection of Jesus whose purification of soul in this life was not yet entirely reconciled and completed, so as to be entirely pure and free from *the effects of sin already forgiven*, or any venial sins still borne by the soul.

All Souls Day Envelopes will be available at the doors of our churches. The donation for an All Souls Day Intention is \$10: for each individual intention, or for each family intention. Please do not put together a huge list of names and/or families under one donation of \$10. And contrary to what you might have heard in current days, going back about 600 years now, *you're not paying for a Mass! You can't do that with a Mass! You can assist a priest's livelihood with a donation on the occasion of a Mass.* Oh...one more thing: no matter how many Masses are offered by a priest on a given day, he can only keep one Mass intention for his own support. Beyond that, all other Mass intentions have to be donated to a charitable cause of his choosing.

A Book of Remembrance will be near the sanctuaries of each of our church sites for those who wish to list the names of friends, family, and loved ones so that they can be remembered in prayer throughout the month of November.
