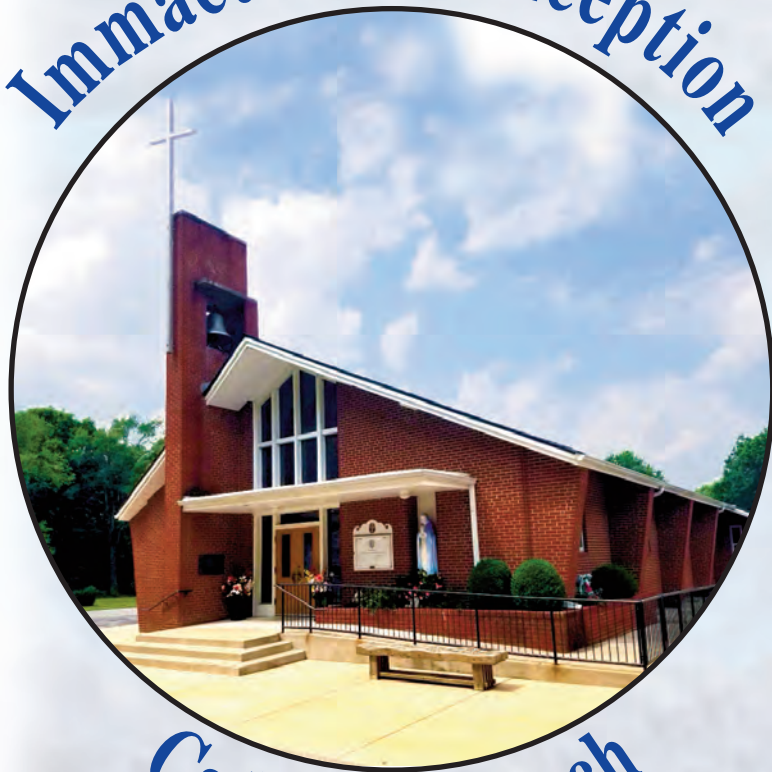

UPDATE: CHURCH LANDSCAPING PROJECT

I have had questions regarding changes I have made and will make to the Church Landscaping. Following is the update.

New shrubs will be planted on the East and North sides of the Church in the Spring of 2026. These will include Abelia, Azalea, and Evergreens. I will be removing the existing overgrown/crowded Boxwood.

Existing shrubs and perennials around the Rectory have been transplanted. New shrubs have been planted in the south-side garden area. The new shrubs are Pugster Blue Dwarf Butterfly Bushes. Transplanting and additions will continue in the Spring.
