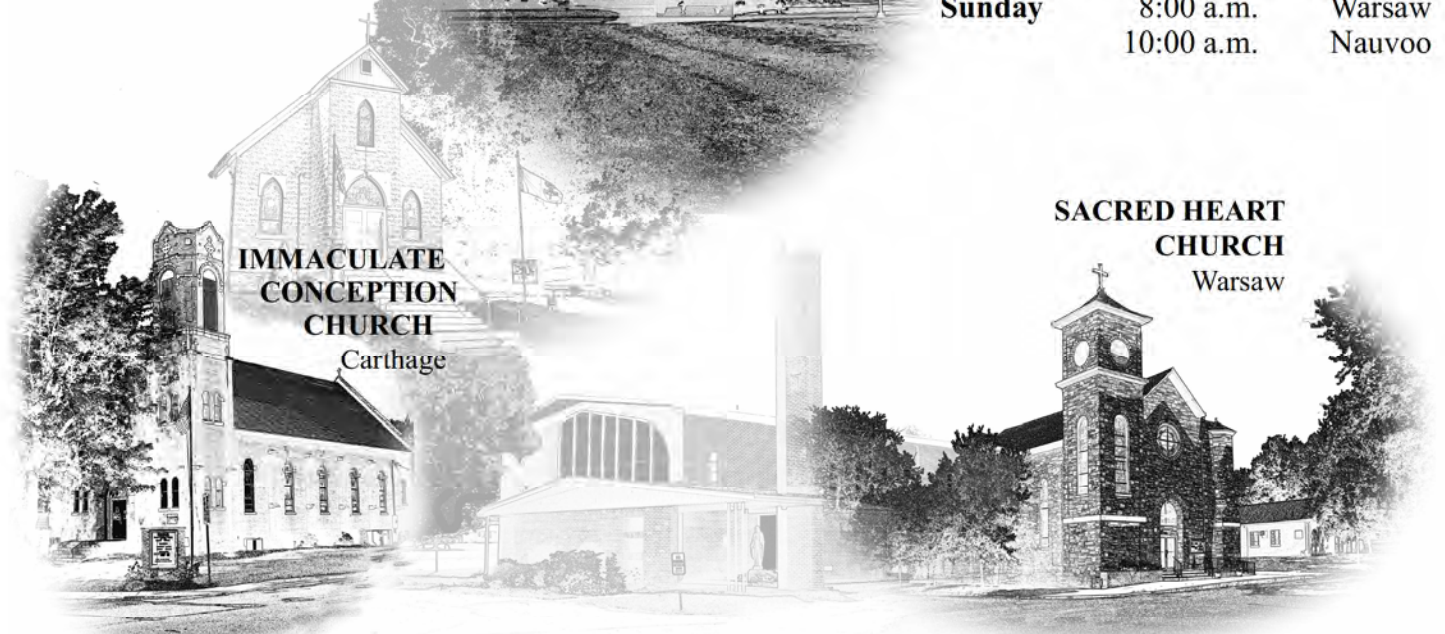

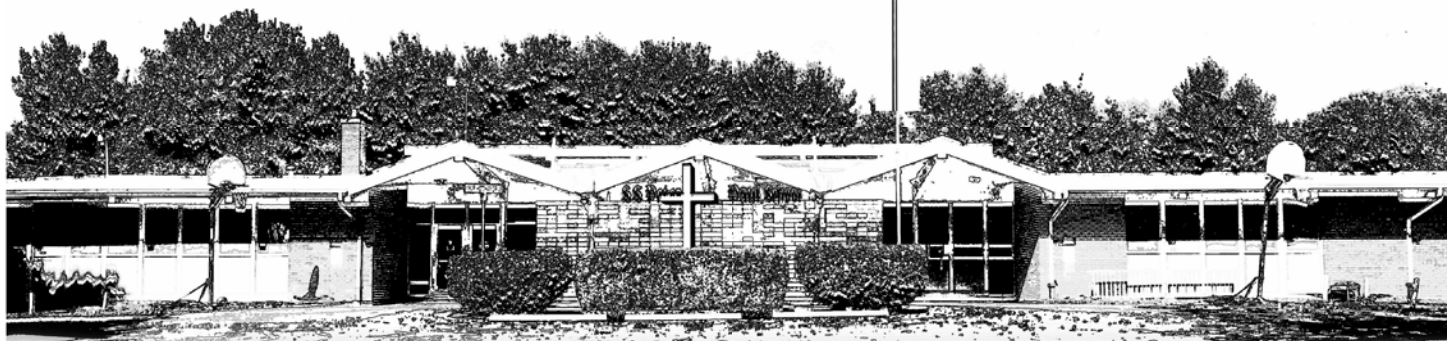

It's Official: Holy Archangels Roman Catholic Congregation of Nauvoo, Illinois.

"I, Most Reverend Louis Tyłka, Bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Peoria, do solemnly swear that the following persons - Most Reverend Louis Tyłka, Bishop, Catholic Diocese of Peoria, Illinois, Monsignor Philip Halfacre, Vicar General, Catholic Diocese of Peoria, Illinois, and Father Anthony Trosley, a Parish Priest in Nauvoo, Illinois, Hancock County, Illinois - were appointed Trustees of Holy Archangels Roman Catholic Congregation of Nauvoo, Illinois in the County of Hancock and State of Illinois...."

We are now, officially in both church and civil law, Holy Archangels Parish. We already have in place the trustees and members of our joint Finance Council, and members of our joint Pastoral Council.

We will keep you informed about the financial / budgetary structure that will be replacing that of four...then three...then five...then six...then five...then three...separate churches. *In the meantime, and until we communicate our readiness to make the change, please continue to give to the parish according to the way you always have, through your membership as indicated among the three church sites.*

On Thanksgiving Day. This Thanksgiving, I am most thankful for the patience and understanding I have received from you in the wake of this nagging leg injury. There have been a few times when I pushed my recovery too hard, and I've had a few setbacks. I underestimate my need for rest because I realize how much and how many are waiting for me. Under these circumstances, your support has been much appreciated. *Because I can get out and about in limited and measured ways, I ask that you please contact me about any serious pastoral care health matters.* On behalf of Fr. Paul, Deacon Dan, and Deacon Tony, our gratefulness for all that you have done for us, and the privilege of being a part of your worship and service to Jesus Christ!

The Season of Advent. The Church takes the time to prepare for the Second Coming of Jesus Christ by following the way the faith of Israel prepared for His First Coming. "I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come." "Thy Kingdom come...." "...as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ." Penance, prayer, and good works to take on an alertness to the coming of the Lord.
