READING 1

EZEKIEL 47:1-2, 8-9, 12

The angel brought me back to the entrance of the temple, and I saw water flowing out from beneath the threshold of the temple toward the east, for the façade of the temple was toward the east; the water flowed down from the southern side of the temple, south of the altar. He led me outside by the north gate, and around to the outer gate facing the east, where I saw water trickling from the southern side. PRIMERA LECTURA

EZEQUIEL 47, 1-2. 8-9. 12

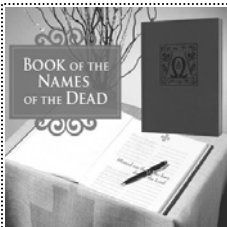

~ **Basketball Registration:** Basketball is open to all youth currently in 3rd-8th grades. Basketball is a diocesan organized sport, so only athletes who attend either a Catholic school or is a parishioner participating in catholic education can register.
~ **Action Requested:** To register your eligible children for basketball, please click on [this link](#) to register. Please register as soon as possible. This helps us in determining if we have enough for multiple grade group teams and schedule the assessments.
~ Teams are made up of boys or girls in the following grades: 3-4, 5-6, and 7-8. If we have enough registrations in any of these gender and grade groupings to have multiple teams, we will hold an assessment to help our coaches in determining team make-up. Assessments will occur the week of October 27-30. If we have multiple 3-4 grade teams, the teams are selected on a parity basis with the goal of balancing the skills of the players.
