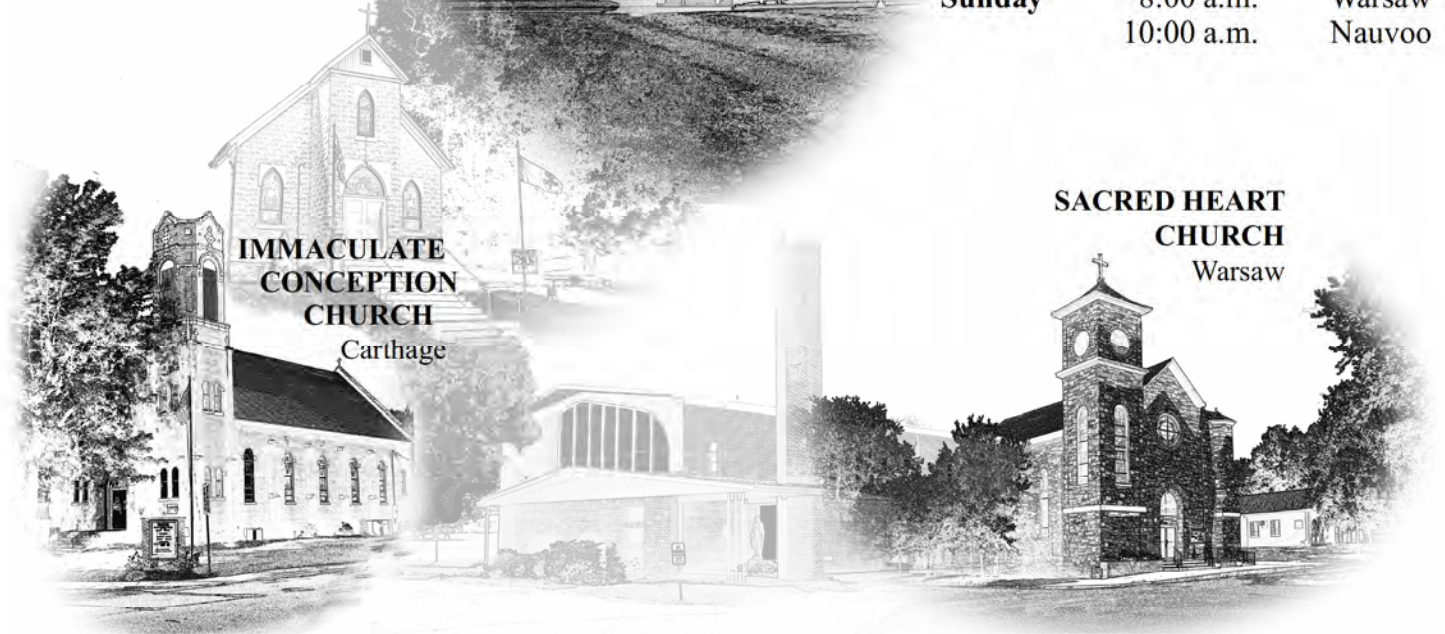

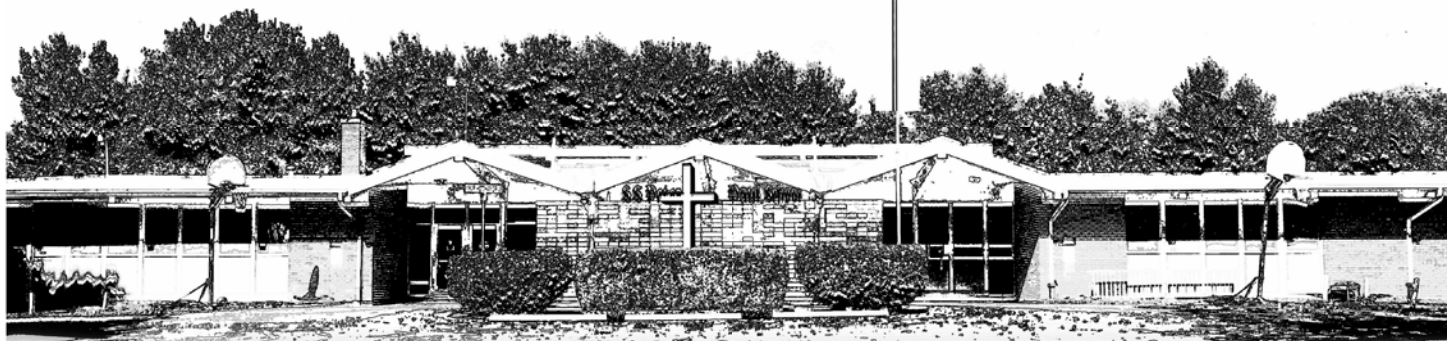

## The Baptism of the Lord

"The Baptism of Jesus is on his part the acceptance and inauguration of his mission as God's Suffering Servant. He allows Himself to be numbered among sinners; He is already 'The Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world.' Already he is anticipating the 'baptism' of his bloody death. Already he is coming to 'fulfill all righteousness,' that is, he is submitting himself entirely to his Father's will: out of love he consents to this baptism of death for the remission of our sins. The Father's voice responds to the Son's acceptance, proclaiming his entire delight in his Son. The Spirit whom Jesus possessed in fullness from his conception comes to 'rest on him.' Jesus will be the source of the Spirit for all mankind. At his baptism 'the heavens were opened' - the heavens that Adam's sins had closed - and the waters were sanctified by the descent of Jesus and the Spirit, a prelude to the new creation." *From the Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraph 536.*

**The Conclusion of the Christmas Season.** For those of you who were at the Mass where Deacon Tony preached, you received a thorough instruction on all the mysteries of our faith contained in the Christmas season. There is...not only Christmas Day, the day of the Incarnation, the birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ; but also, the guides to our life of faith found in: the Holy Family; Mary, the Mother of God; the Epiphany (not just the Wise Men's visit, but also the Baptism of the Lord and the Wedding Feast at Cana - all of that's the Epiphany!); the Baptism of the Lord; and the feast days of St. Stephen, St. John, and the Holy Innocents! And with the Baptism of the Lord, the decorations can come down; Christmas is concluded: all of it! Just don't get into a race with the world out there and plunge into Valentine's Day. Give it a rest!

**Fr. Tony's Absence, early 2026.** These commitments were already established before my leg injury. Considering how long I was "laid up", I feel uneasy about being away. But I can't remove myself from the following: Spiritual Direction for St. Louis Seminarians, January 4-9; and another pilgrimage of prayer for our parish and school, February 1-13. Between Fr. Paul, our deacons, and the generosity of Fr. James, while I'm gone, things will be well taken care of. Just thought I'd let you know in advance. Fr. T.

**Healing Service**, featuring the Sacraments of the Anointing of the Sick and Penance, the ministry of Mr. Roger Shaner, and intercessory prayer to Bishop Fulton Sheen for the sake of miraculous healing and the advancement of his cause for sainthood, will take place on Saturday, January 17, after the 4 p.m. Mass at Carthage. (We ask for patience in the time between the end of Mass and the beginning of the Healing Service. Please allow for the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and introductory prayer before beginning to meet with Mr. Roger Shaner.)

**Let the Children Come to Me...and Let Us Come to the Children.** It's going to be a full month of January 2026 for SPPS! On Friday, January 16, after the 8:30 a.m. Mass at SPPN Church with SPPS kids present, we will have another procession in silence from the church to the school, where Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place, along with Confession.
