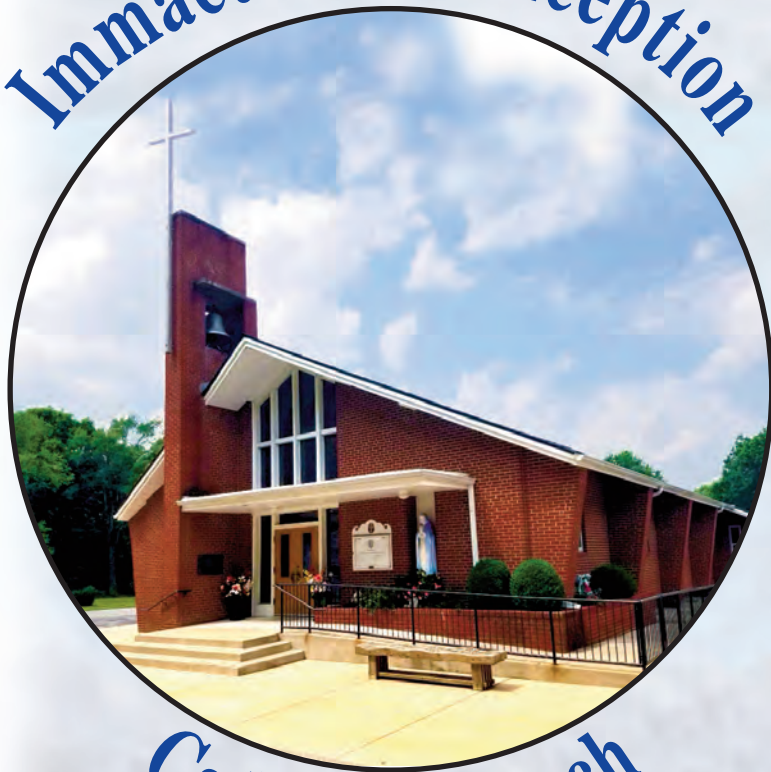

2026 Dale Holt Patriotic Essay Scholarship
