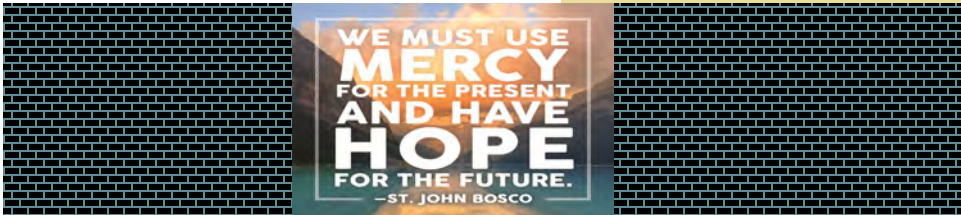

Is 8:23-9:3 / Ps 27:1, 4, 13-14 / 1 Cor 1:10-13, 17 / Mt 4:12-23

In today's Gospel, Jesus calls his first four Apostles: Andrew, Peter, James and John, his "first responders!" 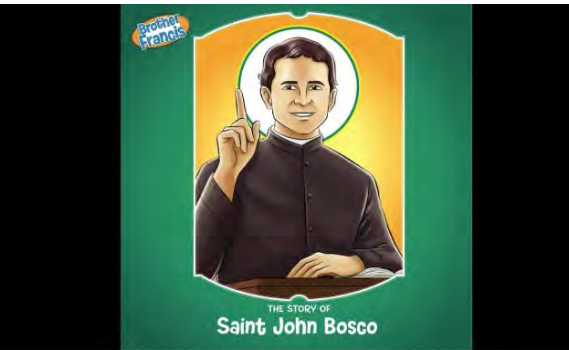
