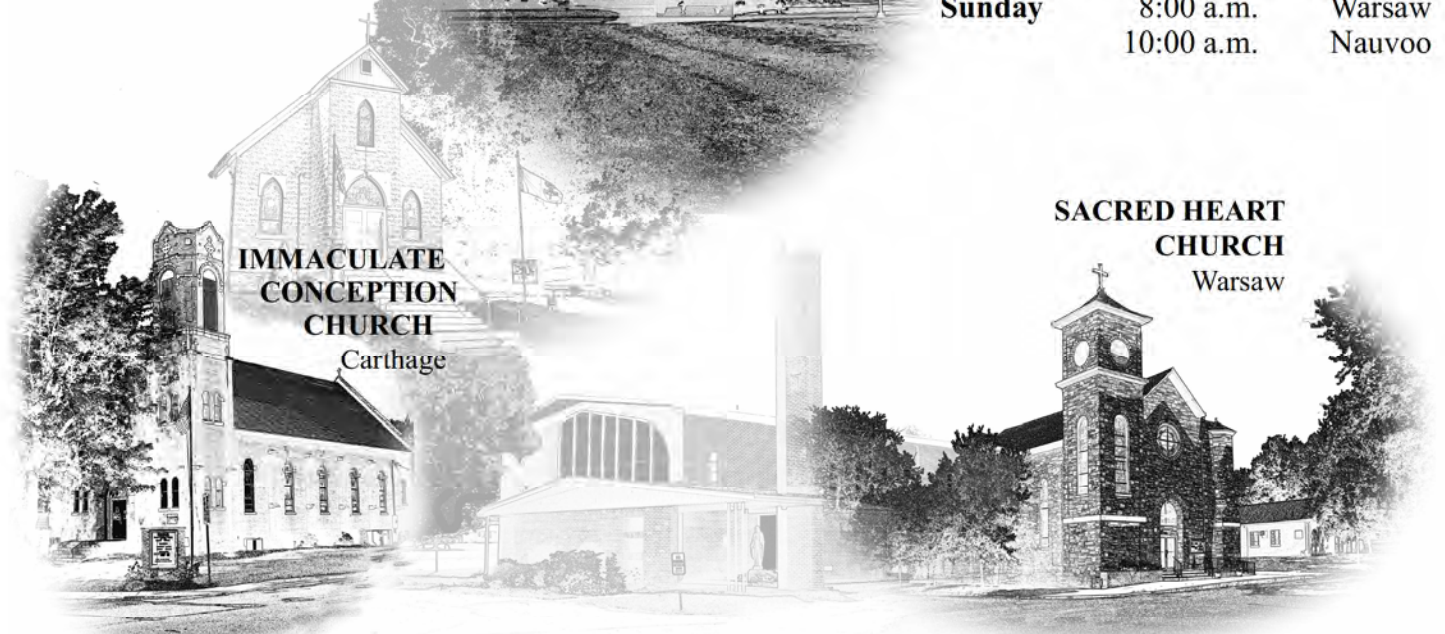

The Catholic Church's Observance of the Season of Lent.

Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. Priests, religious, and laity are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial, attentiveness to prayer, and especially to works of charity and mercy.

Everyone of 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of the season of Lent.

Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday, and Good Friday in the season of Lent. On these two days of fast and abstinence, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.

To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is a serious matter.

Instead of Mass, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, the Scriptural Stations of the Cross, and Benediction on the Friday evenings of Lent. This change also anticipates a future in which Masses will not be as available and flexibly scheduled as they used to be. And don't forget about our Liturgies of the Word, with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and opportunity for Confession, to be scheduled throughout the season of Lent, as we did during Advent.
