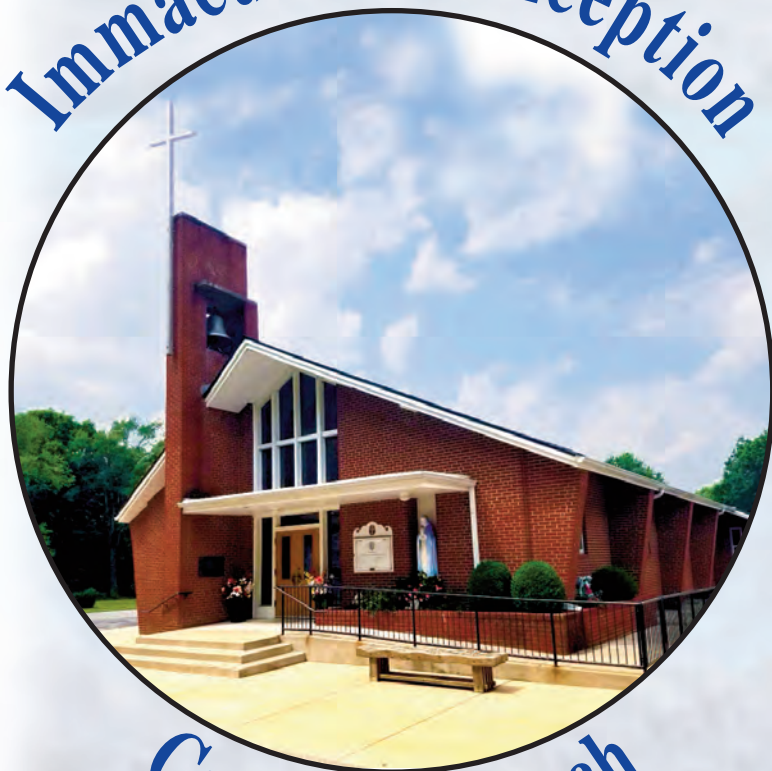

February 19 and every Thursday following until March 26, Exposition after Daily Mass, Adoration, and Benediction at 5 p.m.

February 20 and every Friday after until March 27, Stations of the Cross at 5:30 p.m.

February 25 and every Wednesday evening until April 1, Confessions at 6 p.m. to 6:45 p.m.

April 2 - Holy Thursday, Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, 7 p.m.

April 3 - Stations of the Cross at Noon and Good Friday of the Lord's Passion, 7 p.m.

April 4 - Holy Saturday at the Easter Vigil in the Holy Night of Easter, 8 p.m.

April 5 - The Resurrection of the Lord, 8 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.
