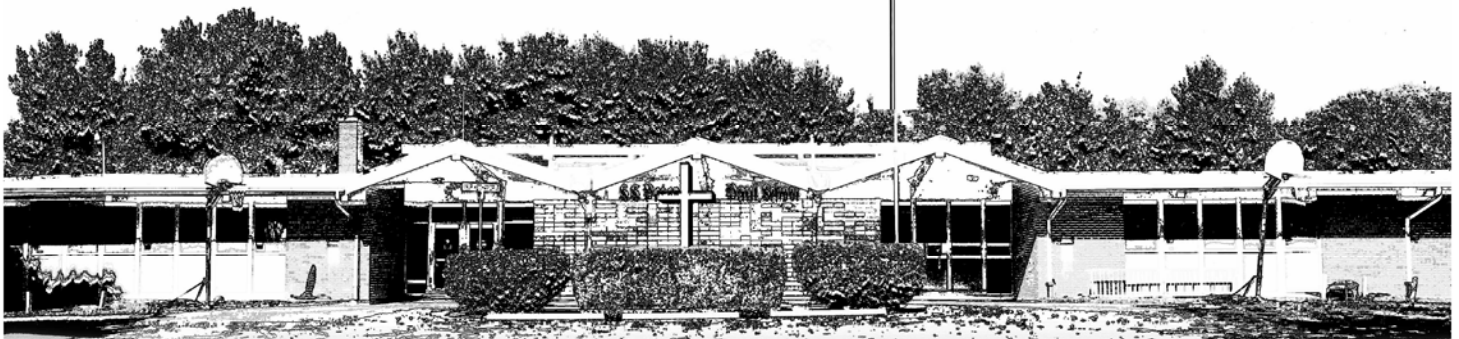

A Parable That Never Made Its Way Into The Bible.

At that time, Jesus said to his disciples: "There was a priest who went on a trip for spiritual and recreational renewal. Along the way, he visited the museum in honor of Mother Angelica of EWTN, the shrine of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, The Washington Monument, The Lincoln Memorial, the Vietnam Memorial, Ford's Theater, and the National Basilica of the Immaculate Conception. As he was leaving the Basilica, a woman came into the church and walked right by him; then she returned and said to him, 'Excuse me, sir. But I haven't eaten in two days and I am homeless. Can you help me with anything? Please?' And the priest offered some assistance. And so it is, in the Kingdom of God: that a planned journey away turned out to be for the sole purpose of being in just the right place, at just the right time, to meet me in the appearance of a homeless woman. And alert to the notice given from above, the priest, upon his return home, was able to respond to five poor and homeless people that I would send his way."
