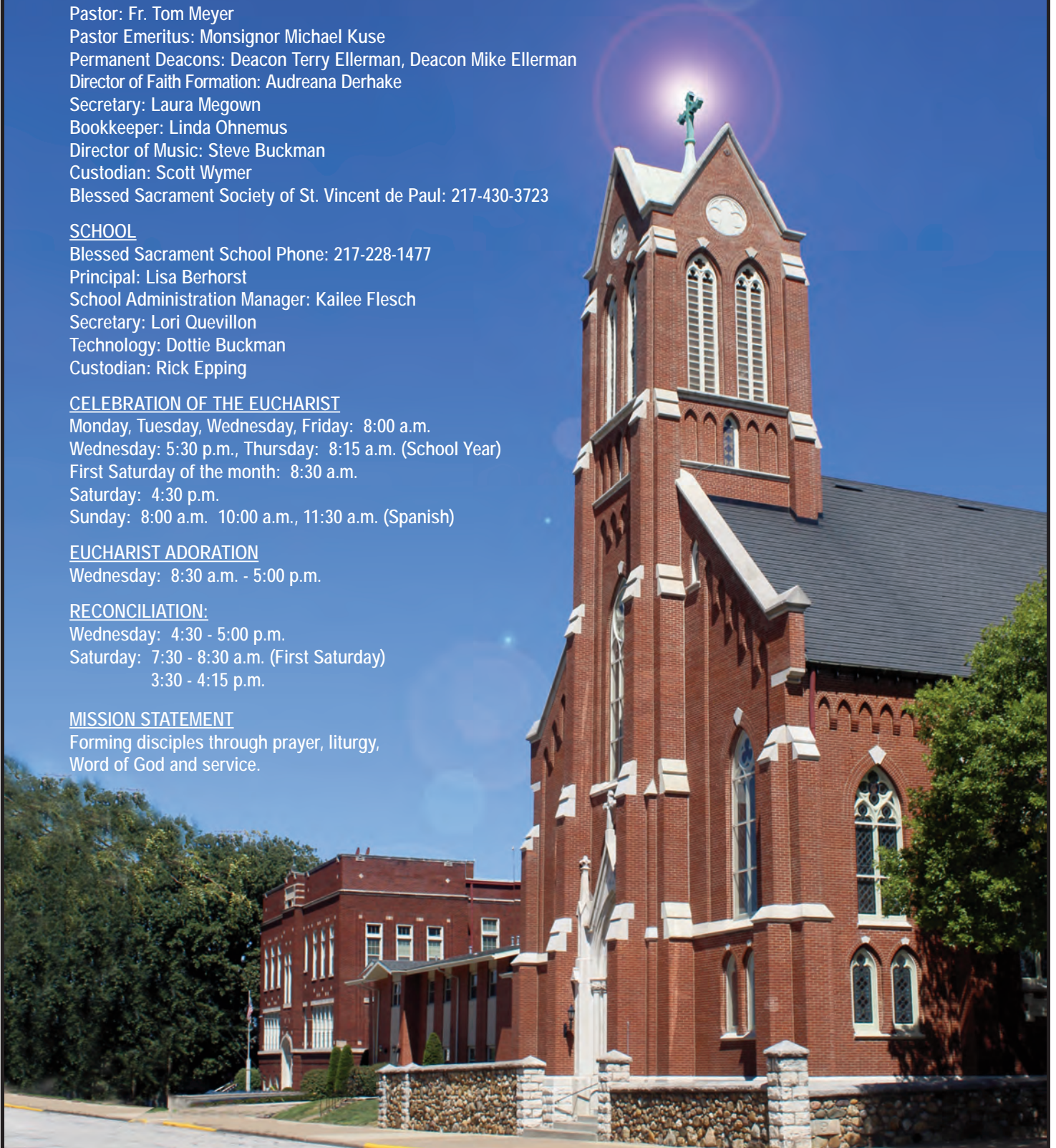

**From the Pastor's Desk**

Today we celebrate the **5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time**. In the gospel Jesus tells his disciples, "You are the salt of the earth... You are the light of the world." What an amazing compliment Jesus is giving to all of us! Despite our sin and self-centeredness Jesus thinks *that* highly of us. And Jesus does not want us to hide the "gift" of ourselves. He encourages us to allow their gifts and talents to shine... all for the glory of God.

This weekend (February 7 -8) at all Masses we will celebrate our annual **Blessing for those Celebrating significant wedding anniversaries**. Our Parish Culture Club has coordinated the details of this blessing. We congratulate all of our married couples celebrating special anniversaries this year!

This weekend (February 7 - 8) we will celebrate the **Commissioning of our New 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Altar Servers**. Our 4<sup>th</sup> Grade class is one of our largest classes in Blessed Sacrament School. We are so very blessed that many of them have agreed to be our altar servers. We welcome them to this beautiful ministry next week of serving the Lord at the altar.

On Friday's at 5:15-6:15 p.m. in the upcoming Season of Lent, I will be presenting a **6-part weekly Lenten Meditations on the "Passion according to St. Matthew."** Each weekly meditation is only 30 minutes long, with a free delicious meatless meal to precede it. I hope it might be a nice way to prepare for the Passion Reading that we will hear this upcoming Palm Sunday. Our Friday evening Lenten schedule will therefore look like this:

- 5:40-6:10 p.m. Lenten Meditation on Passion according to St. Matthew**
- 6:15-6:45 p.m. Stations of the Cross**

During the Season of Lent (February 18 - April 4), **40 Days for Life** will be inviting parish members to sign up for a one-hour time slot to pray in front of our local Walgreen's in order to witness the sanctity of all human life. Please consider signing up for a time slot.

Finally, as a way during Lent to offer more opportunities for Prayer and Eucharistic Adoration, **Blessed Sacrament will offer a Weekly Holy Hour on Sunday mornings from 9:00-10:00 a.m. to include the following:**

- 9:30 - 9:45 a.m. (Sung) Morning Prayer**
- 9:45 a.m. Benediction**

We will begin these five weekly Holy Hours on Sunday, February 22. Please consider using this quiet time for your own prayer and meditation during this upcoming season of Lent.

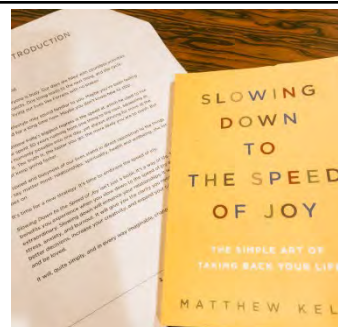
