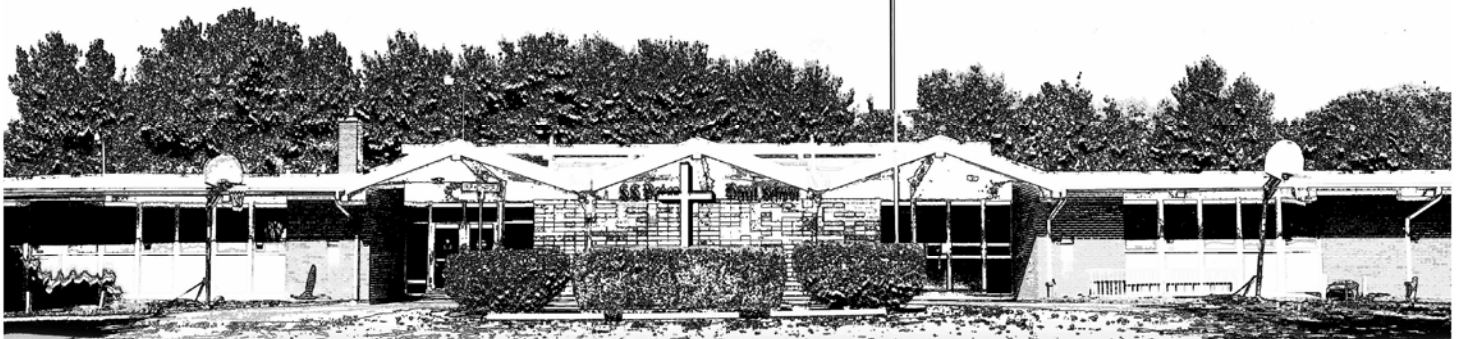

John 9: 1-41. How has Jesus given *you* sight, so that gradually, step by step, *you* see who He really is, and how he is healing *your* spiritual blindness?

John 11: 1-45. When has our Lord not come quickly enough for *you*, in *your* grief, only to find out that He's highlighting what He wants to accomplish in *your* life?
