ST. LUKE SPIRITUAL GROWTH OPPORTUNITIES DURING LENT

Lent is a season of Prayer, Penance and Almsgiving. During the season of Lent we are all called to embrace penances and to perform works of charity that reflect our desire for conversion of heart.
