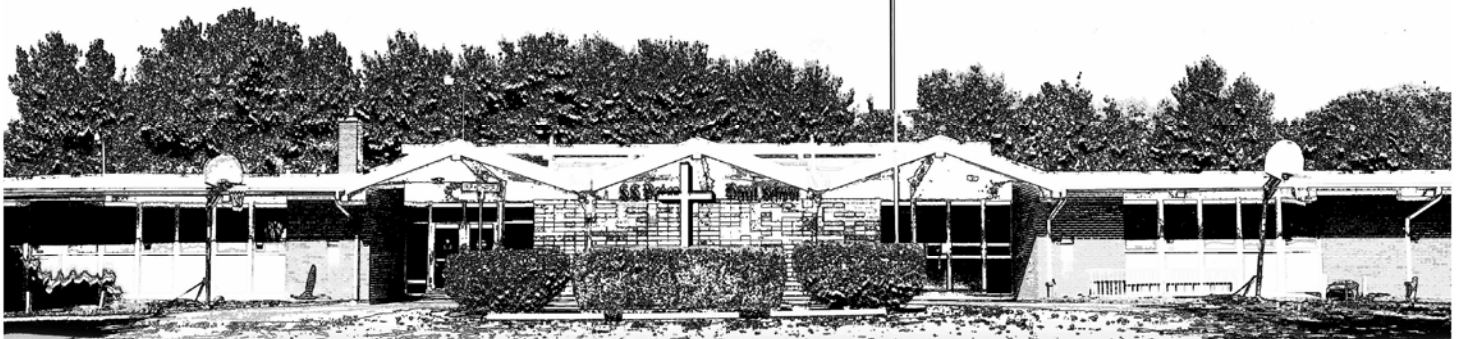

Here's How Jesus is Getting to Know You: Holy Week Part 1

On Passion (Palm) Sunday, the Church as the Body of Christ holds in remembrance (i.e., makes present through the power of the Holy Spirit) the day in which Jesus enters Jerusalem for the final, climactic battle with Satan and the forces of evil for the salvation of our souls. The blessed palms we receive are a sign of triumph, commitment, and loyalty to Jesus as He "enters into the ring" to do battle through the mystery of the Cross. Mass begins with the blessing and distribution of the palms - in good weather, outdoors, with a procession into the Church! The Gospel is the entire Gospel of the Passion: come rested and prepared to pay attention!

On Holy Thursday, the Church as the Body of Christ holds in remembrance (i.e., makes present through the power of the Holy Spirit) the death of Jesus Christ *the night before it actually occurred in history*. Of course, both events occur in history, because in the eyes of the Church, and of Jesus himself, both events *are the same event*. The appearances of bread and wine remain the same, while the essence of the bread and wine become the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. To us, His words meant nothing less than this - *to Him!* We re-enact the washing of the feet of the apostles; the journey to the Garden of Gethsemane with the Blessed Sacrament in procession to the Altar of Reservation; and the stripping of the sanctuary to prepare for the stark reality of Good Friday. We celebrate the Mass as Sacrifice; and *that* means celebrating the priesthood offering the sacrifice; and *that* means the life of service and humility.
