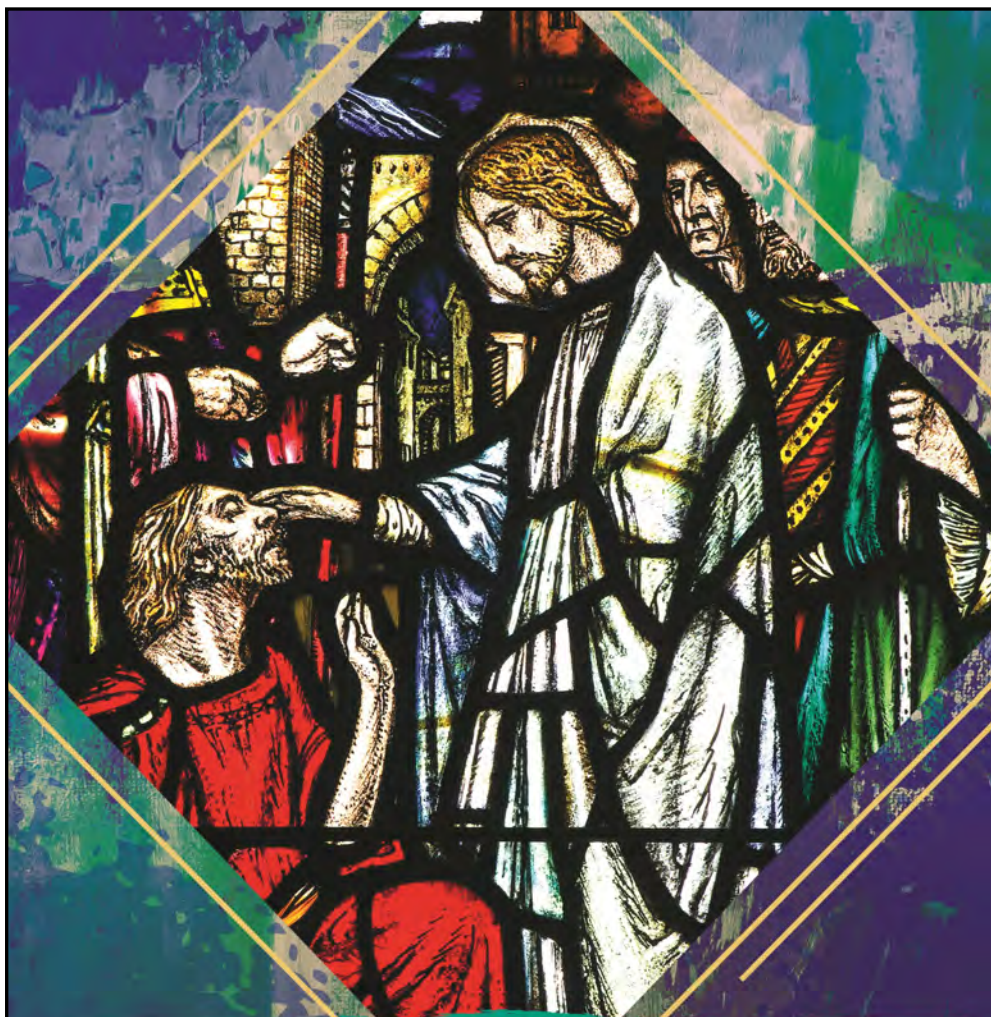

Sight to See - Fourth Sunday of Lent

1 Sm 16:1b, 6-7, 10-13a / Ps 23:1-3a, 3b-4, 5, 6 / Eph 5:8-14 / Jn 9:1-41

God chose David, the youngest of eight brothers, to be his anointed, his king. We can imagine there may have been some animosity among the brothers. They probably couldn't believe their eyes! Even Samuel, God's prophet, had his sights on David's brother. Fast forward to the New Testament and today's Gospel. A man, blind from birth, is given his sight, by Jesus. Having never had his sight, he didn't know what he was missing. The Pharisees, having their sight, couldn't see what they were witnessing! Our eyes can be deceiving and unbelieving. As believers, we can see the bread and wine with our eyes, but by faith we can see the body, blood, soul and divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ. God's ways are not our ways. We are not always going to see what God has envisioned, but we can respond to God's vision.

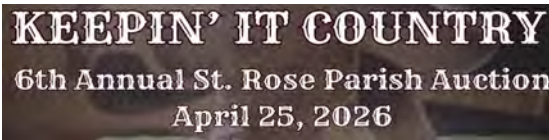
