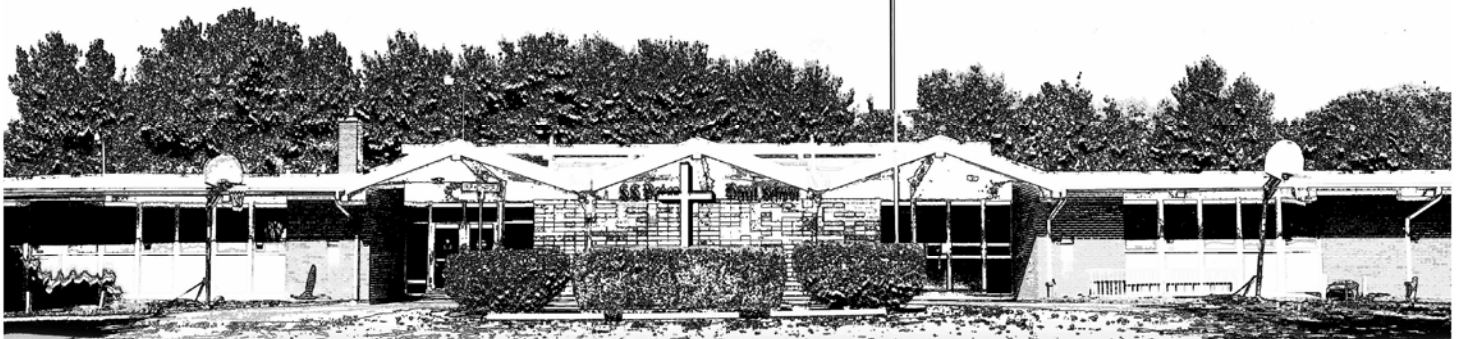

Here's How Jesus Is Getting to Know You: Part II

On Good Friday, the Church as the Body of Christ holds in remembrance (i.e., makes present through the power of the Holy Spirit) the day upon which Jesus Christ died on the Cross for the salvation of the world at three o'clock. This isn't a Mass; this isn't a commemoration of the actual day. This is *the* actual day. The Procession in silence; the Reading of the Passion; the Prayers for the Universal Church; the Veneration of the Cross; the reception of Holy Communion; and the departure from the church in silence are a part of this solemn remembrance.

On Holy Saturday, the Church as the Body of Christ holds in remembrance (i.e., makes present through the power of the Holy Spirit) the moment of the New Passover - from slavery to sin, to freedom in grace, from death to eternal life - established by the bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. The blessing of the fire and the Easter Candle; the procession of the Church in darkness; the lighting of the peoples' candles and singing of the Easter Hymn, the Exultet; The Sacred Readings (this year, four from the Old Testament, one New Testament Epistle, the Easter Alleluia, and the Gospel of the Resurrection of Jesus); the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation on the part of three people who are entering the Catholic Faith; the renewal of Baptism Promises; and the completion of the Mass: *this is a long evening! But it's a look into the way the Church has celebrated the Easter Vigil from her very beginnings. And - if you can imagine this - it's an entire summary of what the Catholic faith is about, in one beautiful and intense liturgy! So come alert, ready, and see for yourself how important Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist are, in your own life of faith.*

The Social Teaching of the Catholic Church series concludes on March 22, 1 to 2 p.m., at Villa Marie Rectory. Session V: "Family: The Foundation of Society."
