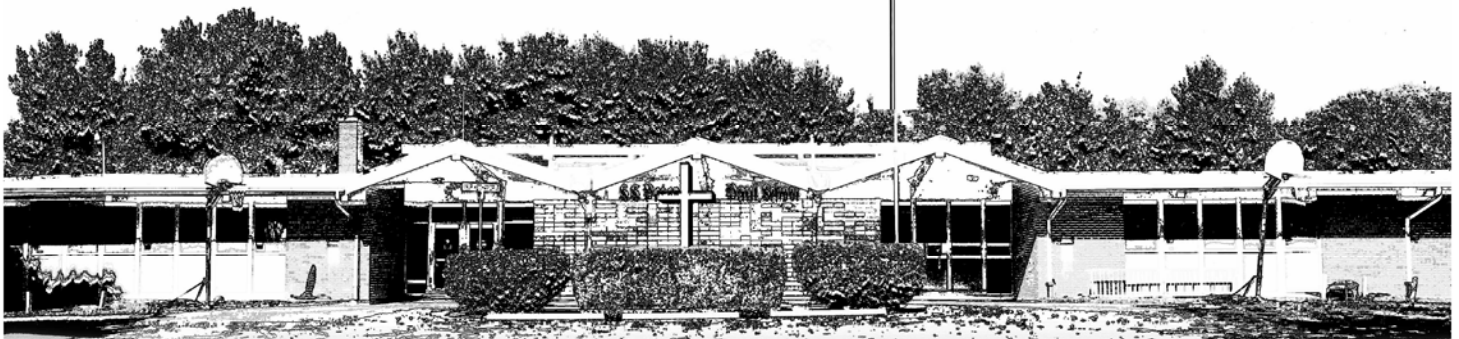

Holy Week and The Paschal Triduum: Masses and Confessions

Palm Sunday: Blessing Distribution of Palms at the beginning of all Masses. Deacons will preach at Saturday 4 p.m. ICC Church site, and 10 a.m. Sunday SPPN Church site; Monsignor Paul Showalter will preach at Sunday 8 a.m. Church site.

Monday of Holy Week: SPPN 5:30 p.m. Liturgy of the Word, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Confessions, 5:45 - 7:00 p.m. (Two confessors available.)

Tuesday of Holy Week: ICC Noon Liturgy of the Word, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Confessions 12:15 - 1:00 p.m. (One confessor.)

Wednesday of Holy Week: SHW 6:15 p.m. Liturgy of the Word, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Confessions 6:30 - 7:30 p.m.

Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper, SPPN, 7:30 p.m.

Good Friday Liturgy of the Lord's Passion, SPPN, 3:00 p.m. (Also: 5:30 p.m. SHW Stations of the Cross; and 7:00 p.m. ICC Outdoor Stations of the Cross, beginning at County Courthouse.)

Holy Saturday Easter Vigil, SPPN, 7:30 p.m.

Easter Sunday Mass of the Resurrection: 8:00 a.m. SHW; 10:00 a.m. at SPPN (Fr. Tony) and ICC (Fr. Paul).

Collection for the Holy Land: A Letter from Bishop Tylka. Our Bishop has written to all the parishes in the diocese about this year's Good Friday Holy Land Collection. He states: "I write you with deep gratitude for your support of last year's collection for the Church in the Holy Land. Your generosity supported 23 parishes and helped keep schools open for over 10,000 Pre-K through grade 12 students. It helped provide assistance to over 9,000 families through weekly food baskets, and to employ more than 1,000 workers in a time where job opportunities are scarce. And it helped preserve 80 shrines promoting the life of Jesus, the Apostles, and prophets. Christians are now less than 2% of the population, with many more potentially leaving. In Bethlehem alone, more than 90 Christian families have left since the fall of 2024. The Holy Shrines must not become like museums - with many visitors, but without a local community. Thank you for your support of the Pontifical Good Friday Collection on April 3. You will join with Catholics around the world to stand in solidarity with the Church in the Holy Land, and become an instrument of peace in a troubled land."

Fr. Tony will be at the Diocesan Chrism Mass on Tuesday of Holy Week. The Chrism Mass highlights the celebration and renewal of commitment on the part of the priests of our diocese, and the blessing and distribution of the Holy Oils: the Oil of the Sick, for the Anointing of the Sick; the Oil of the Catechumens, for the Sacrament of Baptism; and the Sacred Chrism, for the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders. Each of our church sites receives a set of these consecrated oils for the administration of the Sacraments of the Church. We thank our parishioners, Lilian Solano and Laura Merino, for serving as parish representatives to the Chrism Mass for the reception of our sets of Holy Oils.

On the Death of Chuck Norris. Thank you for your many expressions of sympathy sent my way upon hearing the news of the death of Chuck Norris: "Cordell Walker, Texas Ranger". It took me only one episode to be "sold" on the guy: when I saw Walker Texas Ranger go "airborne" to administer a piledriver kick right into the front windshield of an oncoming vehicle, I just knew that was the kind of priest I'd want to be. The sweat tent leading to union with the spirits of the Native American Indians of old; the ability to translate the call of the bald eagle to find good guys and bad guys; the time tunnel through which he made safe passage to see himself as somebody else in the Old West: didn't do much for me. I'm not into the extraordinary or the fantastic. But seeing that foot jet propelled into the windshield of a car speeding toward him, arriving at somebody's face? That everyday stuff was something I could not ignore. (In a more serious vein: as a matter of fact, family and friends are suffering the loss of a loved one. So, gratitude for the entertainment, and prayers, for all concerned.) Fr. T.
