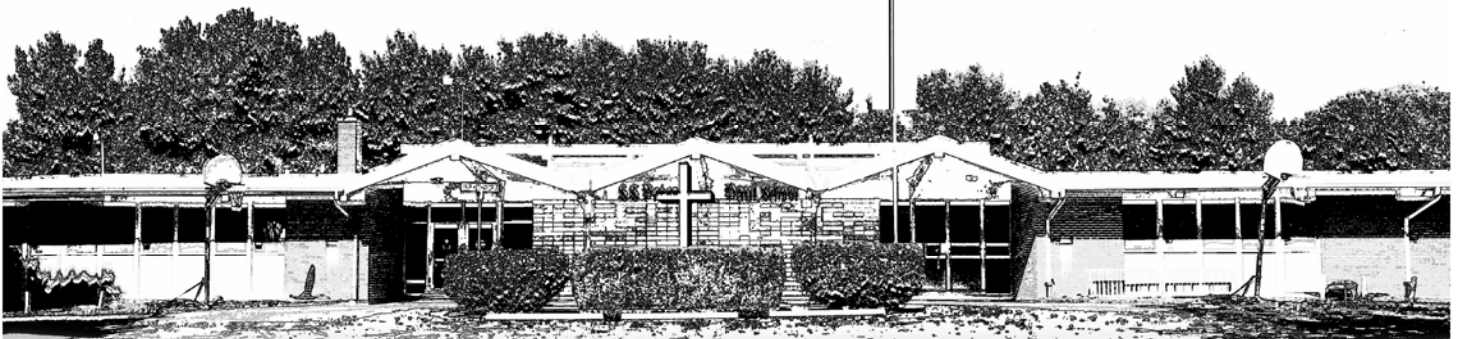

## How Is Jesus Getting You to Know Him? Part II.

We hear and we read the expression, "According to the Scriptures," and the faith of the New Testament in our Bibles stands firm on the position that the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ was announced in the Old Testament for all to see - as long as they were open to the passages about suffering! And yet that very means of salvation is the way chosen from the Holy Trinity from the beginning of time. Besides last week's Biblical passages from the Gospels of this Lenten season, perhaps a few selections from the Book of Psalms would be helpful for prayer and thought, in order to see how the expression, "According to the Scriptures", was, and is, there for all to see. In case the numbering of the Psalms in your Bible are a bit different from that in mine, I'll give the introductory verse as well. Look one Psalm ahead, and one behind, in case you need to!

Psalm 22: "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

Psalm 31: "In you, O Lord, do I seek refuge."

Psalm 35: "Contend, O Lord, with those who contend with me."

Psalm 57: "Be merciful to me, O Lord, for in you I take refuge."

Psalm 69: "Save me, O God! For the waters have come up to my neck."

Psalm 102: "Hear my prayer, O Lord, let my cry come to you."

One more thing: make sure you take note of the positive note at the conclusion of every psalm. That's why Jesus proclaimed from Psalm 22 and Psalm 31 on the cross. Read the whole psalm!
