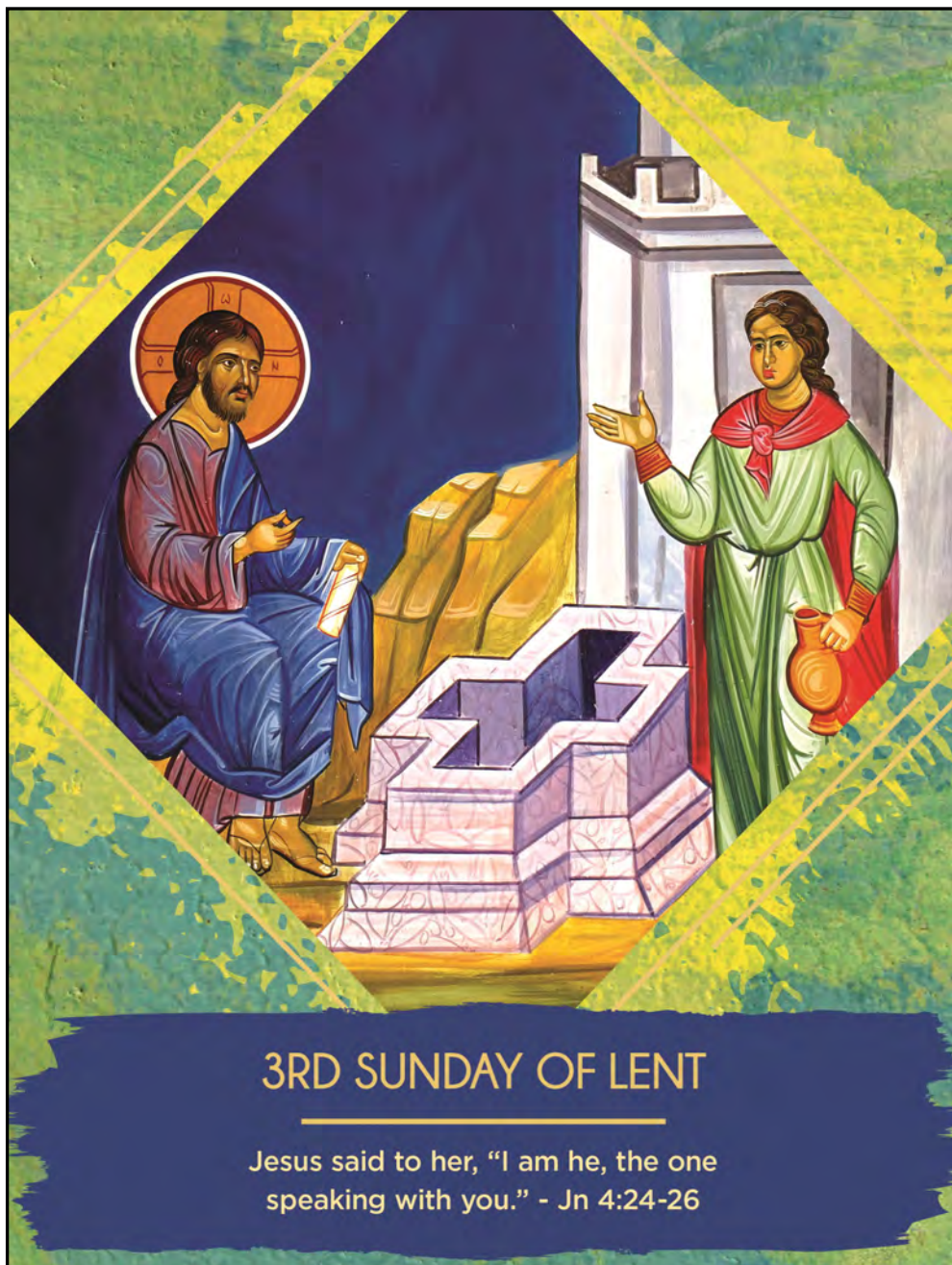

Well, Well, Well - Third Sunday of Lent

Ex 17:3-7 / Ps 95:1-2, 6-7, 8-9 / Rom 5:1-2, 5-8 / Jn 4:5-42

“Give me a drink.” Those were the words Jesus used to introduce himself to the Samarian woman at the well. He certainly got her attention. It is an interesting way to start off a conversation. Give me a drink? Is Jesus thirsty? What if he would have said, “I thirst”? Would the woman have paid any attention? Jesus spoke to her heart. He confronted her. What a gift! How did she respond? Not defensive. She accepted her past. In fact, she darted into town and told anyone who would listen that Jesus knew her past and he could be the Messiah! Are we that anxious to share our encounters at the well? The woman at the well did more than fetch Jesus a drink, she was the staff that drew forth the “living” water for her village, just as Moses did for the Israelites long ago, at Massah and Meribah.

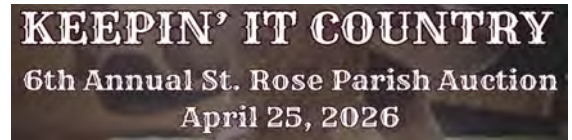
