A most blessed and happy Easter to you. What a joyful celebration we had last weekend as we came to celebrate the Lord's resurrection. He is risen, Alleluia, Alleluia. Thank you for coming and being part of this joyful day. We are now in the Easter season which goes for 50 days taking us to the great feast of Pentecost; the coming of the Holy Spirit. 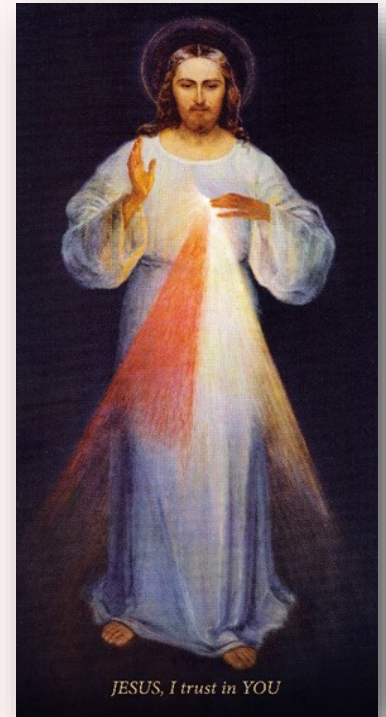
Saint Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina in April 2000 & established that the First Sunday after Easter be known as Mercy Sunday.

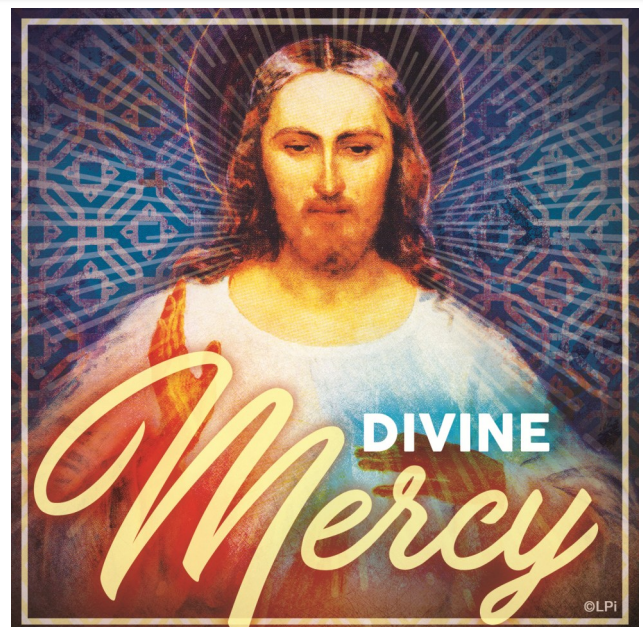
