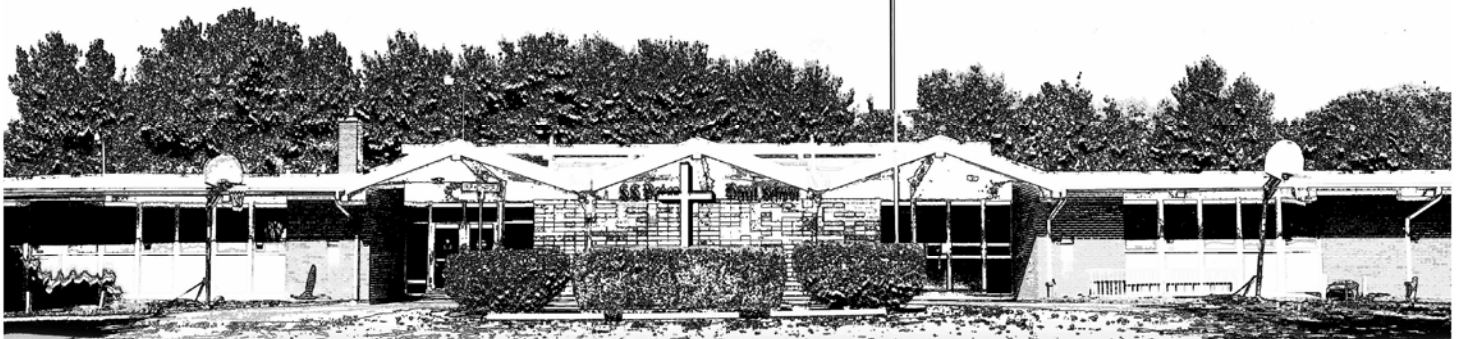

## The Sacrament of Confirmation.

We welcome Bishop Tylka for the celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation on Wednesday, April 22, 6:30 p.m., at the Sts. Peter and Paul Church Site of our Holy Archangels Parish. We are called to remember that the sacred office of the Apostles chosen by Jesus Christ is now extended in time through the presence of the Bishop. The Acts of the Apostles make abundantly clear that there is a Baptism in the name of the Lord Jesus, *and also a distinct Confirmation, a strengthening for witness to Jesus.* We need to support our children, who are receiving the gift of the Holy Spirit administered by the ministry of Bishop Tylka.

We all know the struggle of these days. Faith in Jesus, even more generally faith in God, isn't a problem for most people, young or old - although questions about the existence of God are more prevalent than ever among younger generations. But that Jesus willed that faith be exercised not only as individuals, but as a visible society of people, infused with grace from heaven through the sacraments of the Catholic Church? That we're incorporated into Jesus Christ, as members of his Body on this earth? That my life matters to everyone else who is incorporated into the Body of Christ, and in a way that needs to be experienced and seen? That's a hard sell, even for Catholics, nowadays.

Even with their sincere resolve and desire, confirmands face the hard sell, and it confronts them soon after they receive the sacrament of Confirmation: lots of competition, and different attitudes for different reasons, out there. Let's show them how much this sacrament means to us, and how much their decision to receive Confirmation gives us hope that our Catholic faith will be a shining light for the world into the future.
