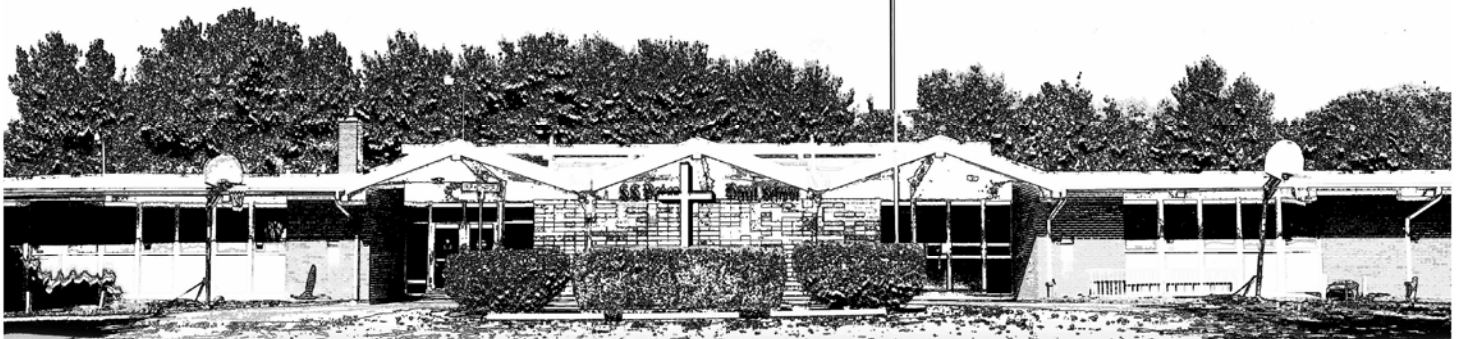

## How About An Update On Things?

There are two things I would like to do as we head into the remainder of the spring, and through the summer months. One is to provide an update on the current status repair, maintenance, and renovation of our Warsaw and Carthage Church sites; and also, to have each of our parish staff members provide a brief summary of their responsibilities and the effect that "Growing Disciples" and other diocesan directives have had on their work. While this won't happen on consecutive weekends, it will happen, as time provides, on weekends through the remaining months leading into September. A few minutes at the end of our Masses: that's when we'll be doing this. It is hoped that you won't leave early unless you absolutely have to, simply for the sake of your being informed, which is your right as a parishioner.

The other matter is to call attention to the need for repair, maintenance and renovation of our Sts. Peter and Paul Church Site and also taking a careful look at the needs for Sts. Peter and Paul School. Now, I'm not aware of too much talk "out there" but from other places I've been, I suspect the possibility of people reacting to supposed decisions already made - there haven't been any - and monetary policy far exceeding our capability - which won't happen. You will see plans for both church and school: not already set in stone, but open to your reaction, with adjustments that can be made within the scope of the presentations themselves. We won't impose the maximum; we won't take for granted the minimum. Nothing kept secret; all, out in the open, with the desire for your input.

It's amazing, my past experience in such matters as this. So many different perspectives coming to the fore - and every single one of them coming from parishioners who care deeply about their parish. I think it's that way here, too. Think about it: no bad guys. Anywhere. Can't go wrong with people like that. Fr. T.
