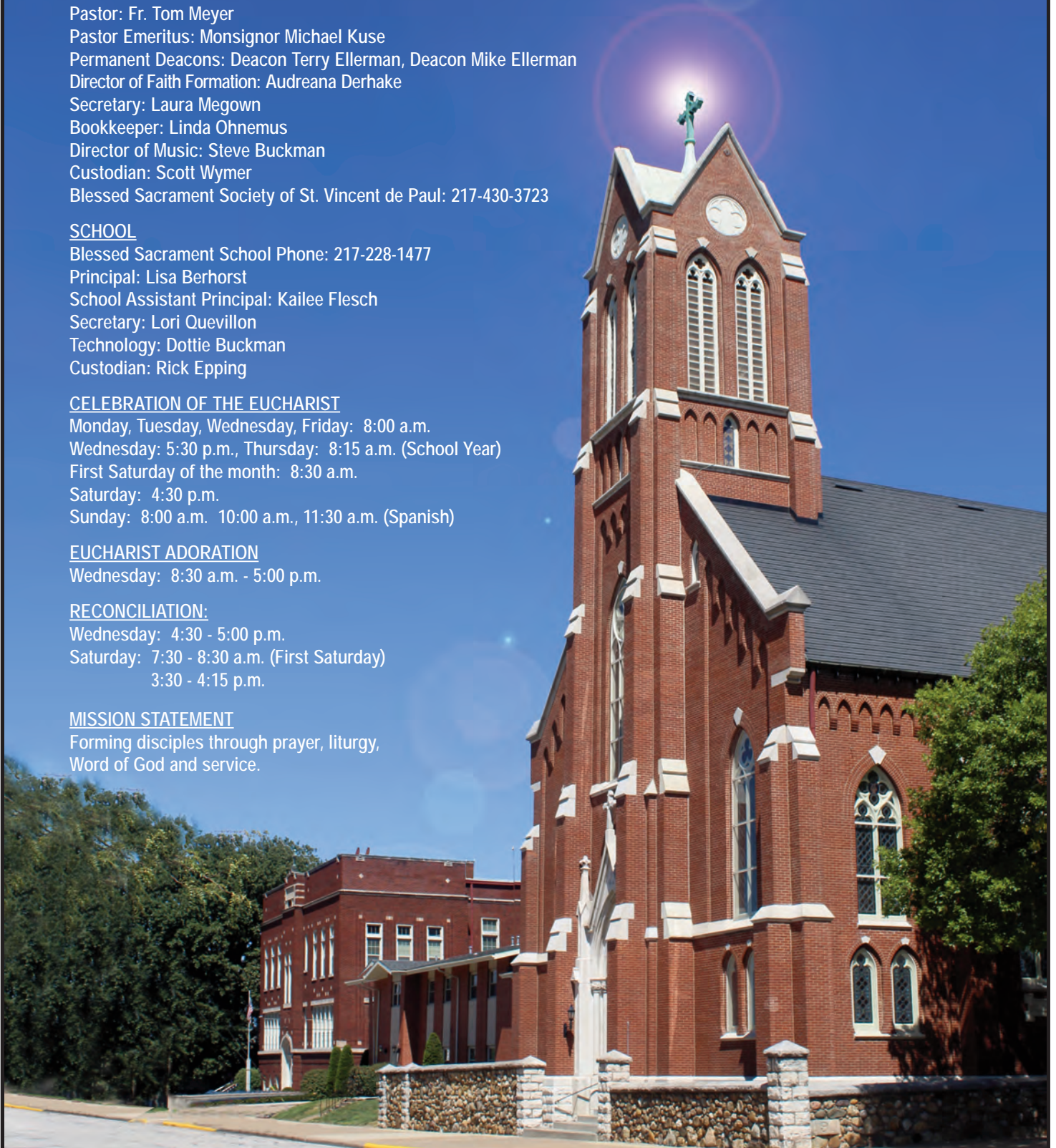

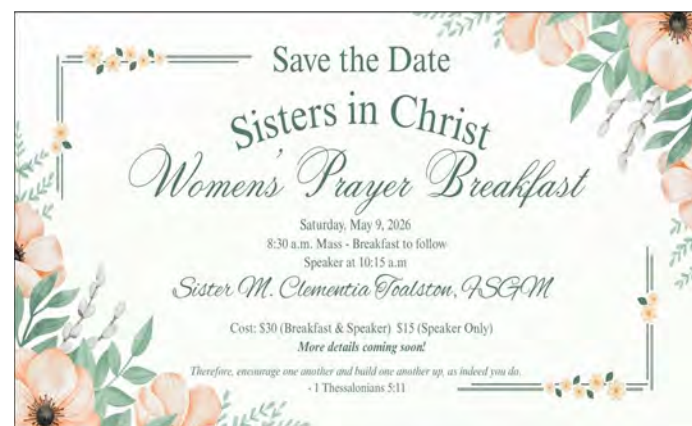


Circle of Caring

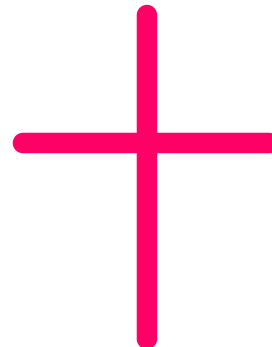
