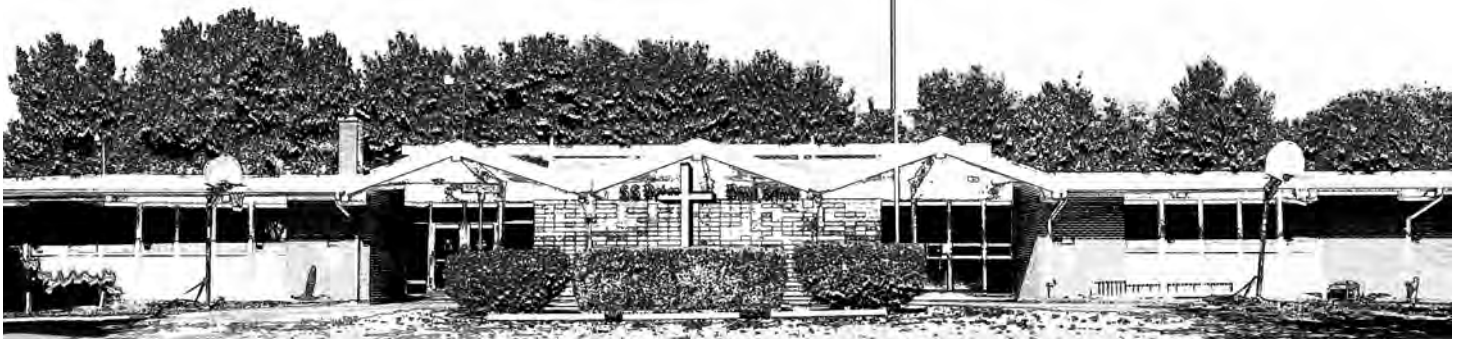

Mother's Day.

This happened years ago...I was assigned to Oglesby, Illinois at the time. I had traveled home on a Sunday afternoon to spend time with Mom. There were weekly errands to run: prescriptions, groceries, bills paid in person, Mass at home: things that were wearying after a four and a half hour trip home. And I had to get back early the next day, Monday morning. So I was in a rush, kissed Mom goodbye, hurried out of the house, got in my car, and took off.

Except I couldn't take off. Something had a hold on me. I couldn't leave home, at least, not yet. I tried to! But it's hard to explain to this day: I drove around the block a few times; took the tour of all the places I spent time as a youth; and hard as I tried, I couldn't leave town.

So, I drove back home, and parked my car on the street, right in front of the house on 557 George Street, Wood River, Illinois. I walked up to the front door, rang the doorbell....

And there was Mom: with her coat on! I told her, "Mom, I couldn't leave..." She cut me short, and said, "I know. I Hop for breakfast?" And we had a nice time together that morning. And I had a four and a half hour trip back to Oglesby, late for everything - and didn't mind one bit.

It has been sixteen years since Mom died, and it seems like only yesterday. Much to remember. Some things I wish I would have done. Constant reminders of how terrific a Mom she was, and still is, from her place in heaven. But that connection she had with my brothers and me - that I didn't realize I had until that morning - is the most satisfying of memories.

Kids of every age - even if you have to go to a cemetery to give a form and a shape to going back home: don't pass up a prompting to get in touch with Mom. I think about the times I could have but didn't - and how many times my Mom had her coat on, waiting at the door. Fr. T
