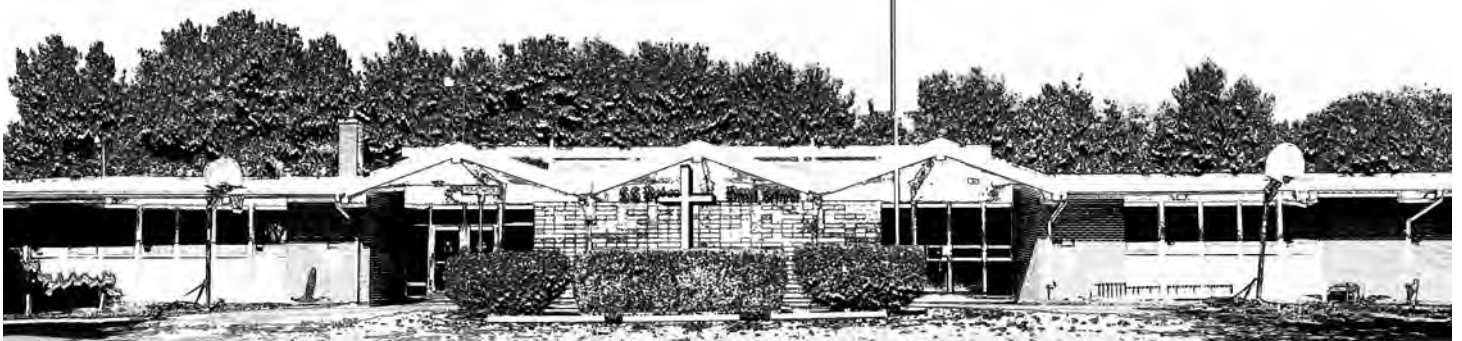

## Ascension, Pentecost...and Graduations!

I think we've failed in educating and forming the spiritual lives of our people about a dynamic participation taking place in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. We need to see the birth, life, suffering, death, entombment, resurrection, ascension, and sending of the Holy Spirit of Jesus Christ as a perpetual upward movement to heaven. You see, Jesus Christ took on a human nature, while still being an eternal God; therefore, the events of His life on earth and in resurrected transfiguration have an eternal movement, an "upward calling," Scripture calls it. We who are baptized and receive the sacraments are on the "escalator" perpetually "going up," even now. This dynamic movement is made present by the Ascension of Jesus; our "riding to the top" with Him is what Pentecost is all about. The Holy Spirit is the "point" at which the Father and the Son's union as one God manifests the Holy Spirit, much like fireworks reach the heights of the sky, and then are set off to spill over into multiple colors for all to see - the Spirit's gifts to us, by which we make our way up the path marked out by our Lord's Ascension. That's the Mass, folks. That's why we hope that at least you think twice about having one for a funeral. Your whole life is one with the Lord's whole life, heading up - and arriving!

I hope graduates at all levels can somehow see their accomplishments and their advancement this way: they're on their way to more than their future vocation, family, and career. They achieve a step toward their ongoing upward call, on the pathway of the Ascension, marked out by the Holy Spirit's guidance in their lives. Fr. T.

While we might not be the immediate beneficiaries of the newly and recently ordained, we've had our turn in recent years. And the entire diocese is better off for newly ordained priests anywhere in the diocese.

**Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.** As part of the ongoing celebration of the 150th Anniversary of the diocese of Peoria, we are consecrating our diocese to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Consecration Mass is June 12, 2026, The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, at the Cathedral of St. Mary, at 5:00 p.m. We are asked to send two representatives to this Mass. We will also have Masses extending this Consecration at each of the Churches of the Macomb Vicariate. Holy Archangels Parish is scheduled for Friday, November 6, at 5:30 p.m. We are awaiting materials and resources from the Diocese to assist us in our devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and will keep you informed.

**150th Anniversary Edition of the Pictorial Book of Parishes and their Churches in our Diocese.** We should be having our shipment come in any time now. We will have a display available for our people to review at each of our Church sites. The price of this memorial of our diocesan anniversary is \$50. So, any time now....!!

**Another School Year at SPPS Comes to a Close.** Our 6th graders will celebrate a Graduation Mass on May 20. The School Picnic will be May 21. The last day of school will be May 22. Wednesday through Friday, and another grateful yet hard parting comes to us. Congratulations to our graduates who are moving on into junior high! No doubt, summer will be a blur, and before you know it, it will be mid-August. But let's not think too far ahead! A blessed and safe summer to all!

**We Have A 60th Anniversary Coming Up!** Prayers and congratulations to our Monsignor "Fr. Paul" Showalter, who, on May 22, will celebrate his 60th anniversary of his ordination as a Catholic Priest. In honor of this grace and achievement, Fr. Paul will be the main celebrant for the 10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass at Sts. Peter and Paul Church Nauvoo on May 24. And afterwards, a potluck luncheon will follow at approximately 11:30 a.m. at the Knights of Columbus Hall. Roast beef, ham, cake, beverages, and table service will be provided. His years in service to the diocese of Peoria include being pastor here from 1980 to 1992, and Vicar General under the episcopate of Bishop Daniel Jenky. And now, the part he has played in the renewal of our newly aligned parish! **Looking Ahead.** Bishop Tylka has asked the priests of our diocese to join him in a Priest Convocation taking place from the afternoon of Sunday, June 14 through Thursday, June 18. And on June 19, the world-renowned classical organist Paula Pugh Romanoux will perform an organ concert at Sts. Peter and Paul Church Nauvoo on June 19, from 6 to 9 p.m. More information will be forthcoming, but for now, just know what's included on our calendar in the coming weeks.

**Healing Service.** Our Healing Service, including the Sacraments of the Anointing of the Sick and Penance, the ministry of Mr. Roger Shaner, and intercessory prayer to Bishop Fulton Sheen, will take place on Saturday evening, May 16, at Immaculate Conception Church Carthage, beginning after the conclusion of the 4 p.m. Saturday evening Mass.
