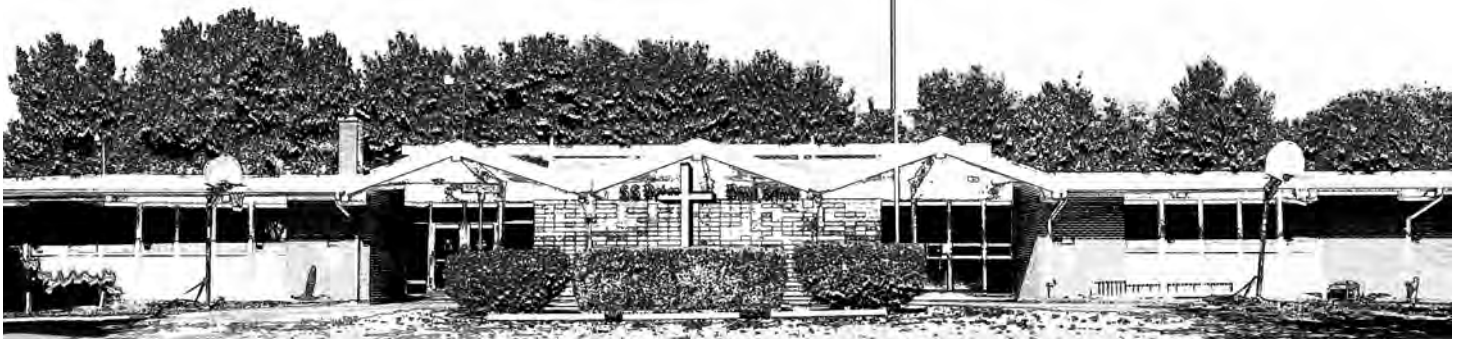

Silver Rose Comes to Carthage - A silver rose on a nine-month pilgrimage will be the centerpiece of a special prayer service at the **Our Lady of Guadalupe Grotto** at Immaculate Conception in Carthage on **Thursday, June 4 at 6:00 p.m.** The program is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe and express both international unity and dedication to the sanctity of human life. The journey of the silver rose begins each year in March and ends on December 12, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. During that time, Silver Roses travel from town to town along eight routes throughout North America starting in Canada and ending in Mexico.
