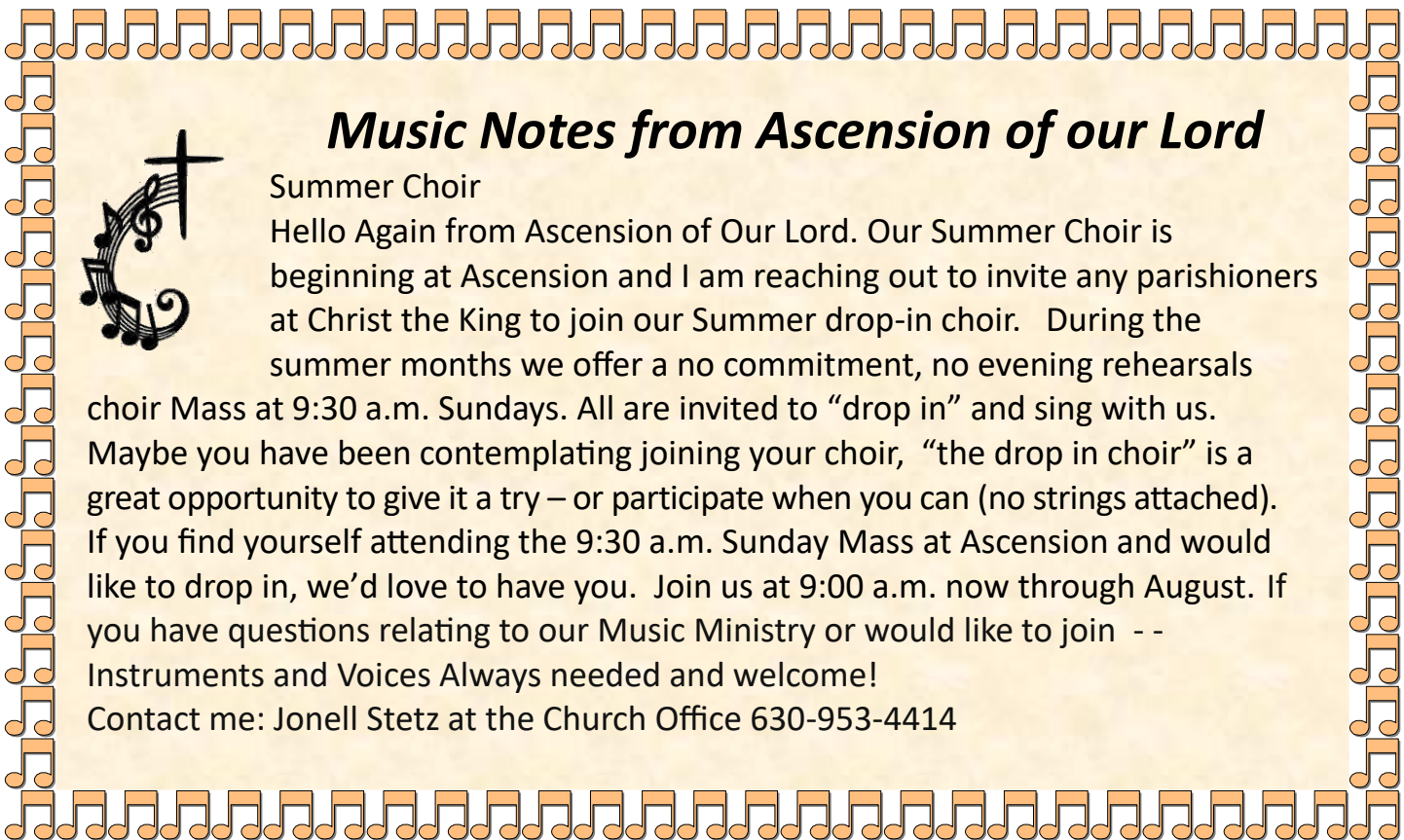


Now would **you** be interested in showing off your nationality cooking skills and tempting our taste buds!

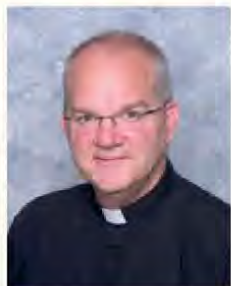
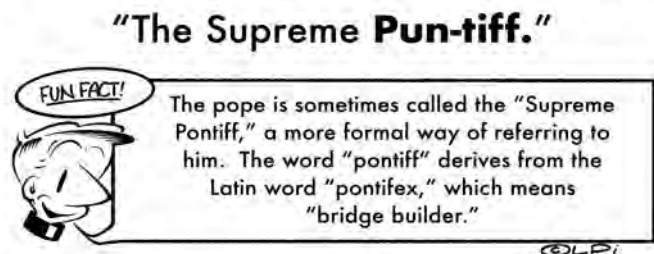
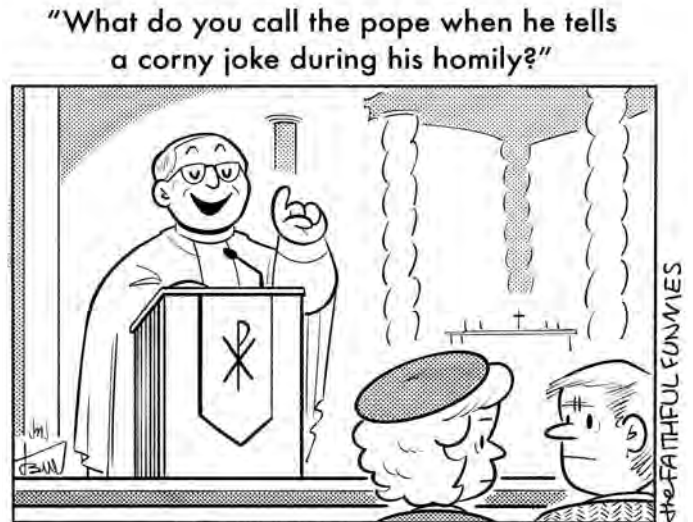
