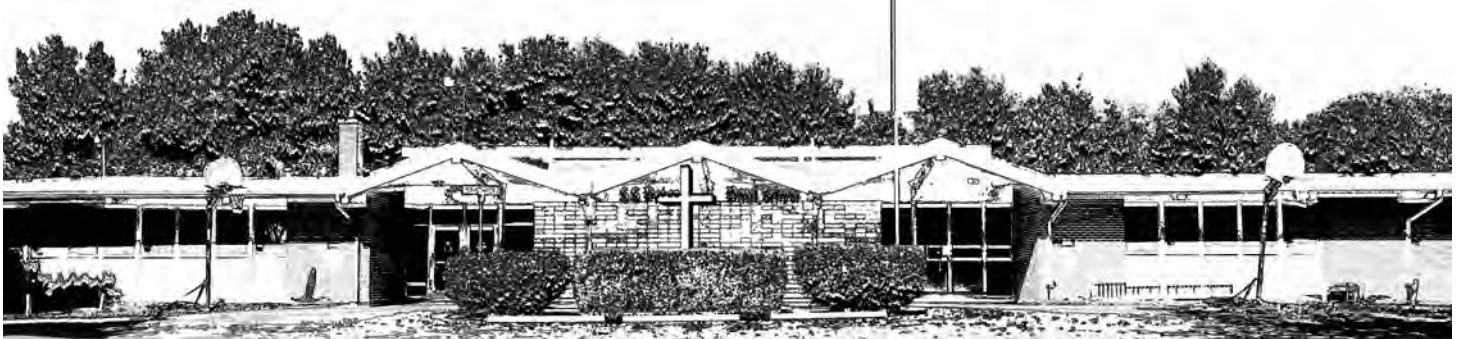

## Here's what "Only Just Begun" Means!

Some of you have already heard this by way of the weekend sermon; others will have to wait a week. Eventually, we'll get around to everybody. There are some things that can't be delayed or "put off" anymore. And among "some of those things" are these:

The Mass Schedule Survey indicated a 65% favorability for the Mass schedule to remain as it currently is. Considering what we've experienced up to this time, I'm not about to change the Mass schedule with this strong a favorability demonstrated by our parishioners.

Religious education for grade school students outside of our Sts. Peter and Paul School will be centralized at Immaculate Conception Church in Carthage, with provision for home school access, or even registration in a religious education program in nearby parishes. The program will take place on Saturday, and the Class schedule will be expanded. Parents will have access to the schedule, scope, and curriculum involved in the very near future.

Besides Masses with organ or piano music, we will also begin Masses with music accompanied by guitar and other instruments lending themselves to sacred music. We intend to have our organists/keyboardists leading the music two weekends a month, and our new music addition two weekends a month. This music schedule will be in place for all Masses each weekend: organ/keyboard at all the Masses of a given weekend; ensemble at all the Masses assigned, as well.

More to come, about Confirmation, additional staff, roles for each of our church sites, our Nauvoo church site & our school, and other developments, next week! Fr. T.

**Once-In-A-Lifetime Organ Concert!** We are pleased, and very much honored, to announce that Dr. Paula Pugh Romanau, Ph.D. and D.M.A. in classical organ, will present a concert of 17th and 18th century French organ masterworks on Friday, June 19, 7:00 p.m., at Sts. Peter and Paul Church Site of Holy Archangels Parish, in Nauvoo. This invitation is going out to musicians and members of the various communities of faith in the Tri-State Area. Dr. Romanau "discovered" our Hook Organ upon Arrival for an initial practice here and can demonstrate and teach – even "demystify!" – various ornamentation techniques for classical organ repertoire, hymnody, and other church-related accompaniment.
