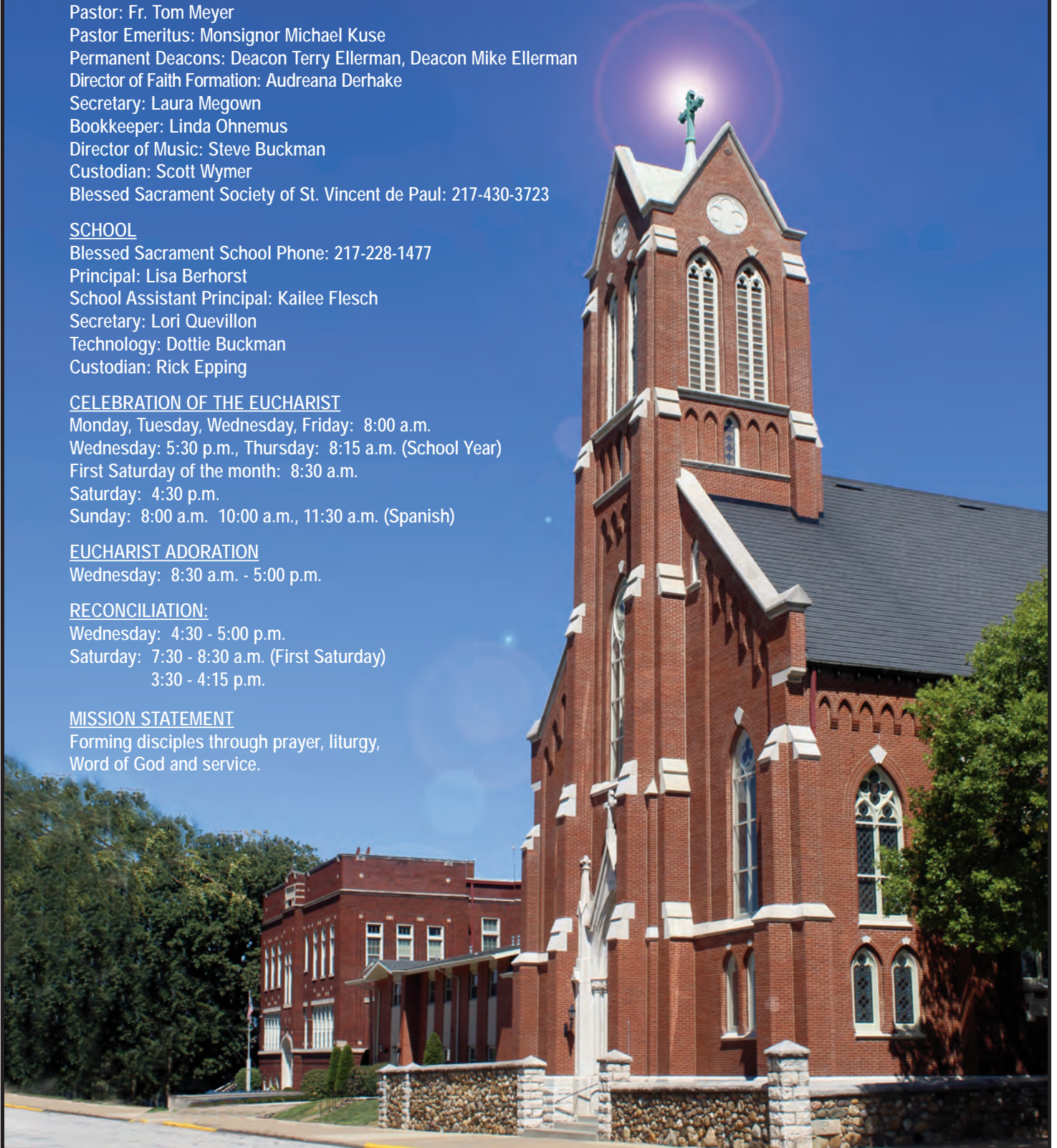

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate **12th Sunday of Ordinary Time**. "Fear no one." One of our greatest obstacles in our spiritual lives is fear. It can paralyze us from becoming the best version of ourselves. In the Gospel today Jesus uses the example of sparrows to illustrate our Father's care. "Yet not one of (these sparrows) falls to the ground without your Father's knowledge...you are worth more than many sparrows." The Lord watches carefully over all creation, and we His children are His most valuable treasure. We often forget how cherished we are. Our Father will not allow anything to harm His most valuable creation. "So do not be afraid."

For the four weeks of June, I will be offering **Two Thursday Bible Studies (morning and evening)** for those interested in studying the Daily First Readings. Each session will be 45 minutes long, with the final 10 minutes available for Question and Answers.

During my absence **Fr. Troy Niemerg** (Ordained 2024) of Quincy University will cover the daily and weekend Masses from July 1-18. Cross Catholic Outreach will be sending Fr. Jude to cover on the weekend of July 18-19. I thank you all for this opportunity of formation and study away from the parish.

Finally, today is **Father's Day!** I would like to extend a Happy Father's Day to all of our fathers throughout the parish. May the good Lord continue to bless you as you shepherd and provide for the many spiritual and physical needs of your families.

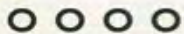
