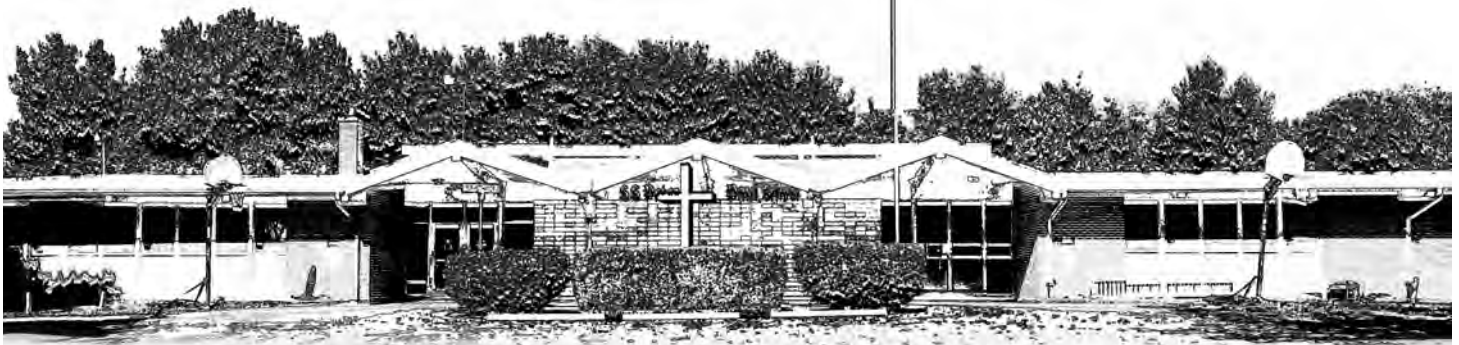

Here's What "Only Just Begun" Means: Part II.

A reminder: The Pastor's sermon at Masses on the June 13/14 weekend will have taken place at Carthage and Warsaw; Nauvoo will hear a similar sermon on the June 20/21 weekend.

The celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation for SPPS and our CCD religious education will take place in the sixth grade, beginning with the celebration of Confirmation in the spring of 2027. There will be a phase-in period during the coming school year, with 6th, 7th, and 8th graders being confirmed in the spring of 2027. We concede accommodations in sacrament preparation so that by 2027-28 school year, and from that point forward, Confirmation will take place in the 6th grade. Our clergy and lay catechist will be involved in Confirmation preparation this coming year.

Due to the generous donation of a parishioner four years ago, who wanted his gift to attend to the need for young adult/family outreach and ministry, we are committed to having someone for this position this coming year. We are currently looking into the FOCUS ministry, whose members are specially formed and educated in precisely this much needed effort.

Both junior high school and high school students will each have youth groups, taking place on Sunday evenings. Besides the youth group focus, there will also be a curriculum for students who want to have a more structured knowledge-based presentation of our faith.

Each church site will have an identifiable focus and share in the work of teaching and spreading the Gospel. For Nauvoo, this will be SPPS; for Carthage, this will be religious education and faith formation for CCD, OCIA, and Latino Ministry; for Warsaw, this will be weekend retreats, faith formation series, discussion groups, and guest speakers for the entire parish.

More to come, about the approaching Capital Campaign for the Holy Archangels parish / SPPN Church site and SPPS. Please be patient, as over the next several weeks, I attempt to address these matters through Sunday sermons, as the Mass schedule shifts from week to week. Fr. T.

LDS Temple Visitor Center Dedication Coming Up On June 26, Fr. Tony will be meeting with one of the LDS Apostles from Salt Lake City. On June 27, the Temple Visitor Center will be formally dedicated, and Wells Street will be closed off. June 27 is a Saturday: short of a funeral, there's nothing that should prevent the closing of Wells Street; and should a funeral occur, LDS officials have assured me that nothing will impede our needs if a funeral needs to be scheduled. We're about to see how the parking on Wells Street actually works out; we are addressing the need to secure parking on Wells Street for our Sunday morning Mass with LDS officials. (Just when you think it's never going to end...you find out you're right!!).
