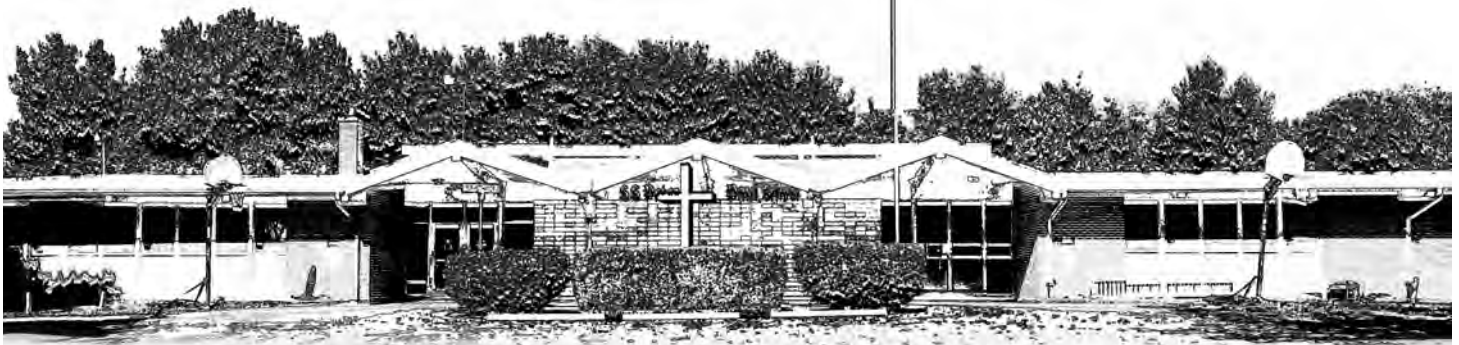

And I'm picking up that I might be dragging out our Growing Disciples effort longer than necessary. I haven't been aware of the perception - or actual fact, whatever the state of things. But I am aware that there are a good number of people who would like me to sound like I'm moving on into our future.

So, let's sound that way: let's do it. We are Holy Archangels Parish now, at Sts. Peter and Paul, Immaculate Conception, and Sacred Heart Churches...Church sites. But our church sites are Holy Archangels Parish. Financially, we are now officially structured as one parish. Organizationally, we're moving toward committees, organizations, and ministries coming together as one, for our one parish. And we have a Capital Campaign coming for Sts. Peter and Paul Church, an effort about to enter into its beginning, and it includes our school. Remember what we've done, over many years, to bring all of our churches to support our school, and to maintain - even expand - that support throughout the entire county. Holy Archangels Parish: that's us. Now. And into the future.
