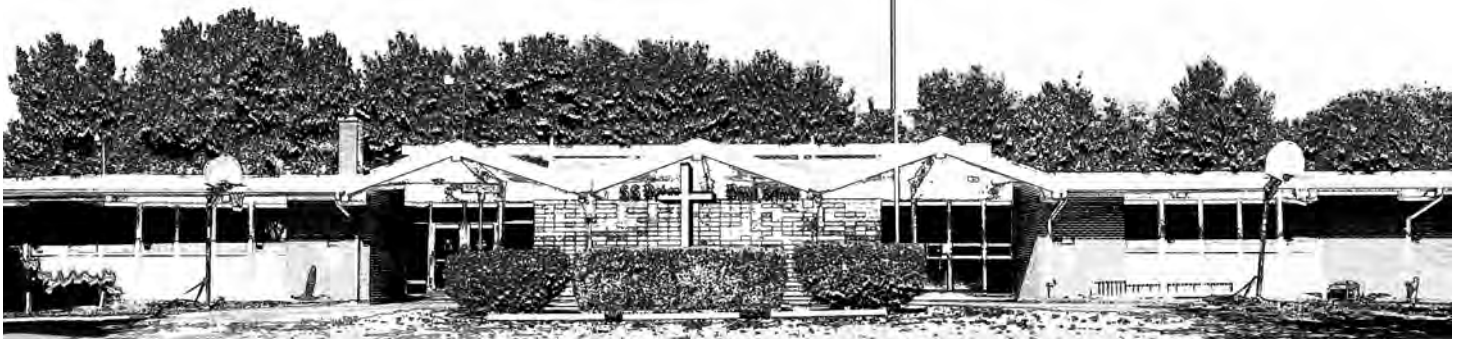

Clint Black, unless I'm mistaken. I think that's when the Church tightened the music scene up a bit.

Once we get past God's Portion Day, I intend to speak to each church site about the following: the Mass Survey results; the role each church site will play in the spread of the Gospel both within and beyond our parish; revisions in CCD; junior high and high school youth groups; junior high and high school Bible and Catechism curriculum; FOCUS Missionary and Called and Gifted updates; a brief address from each member of our parish throughout the summer; capital improvement updates for each of our church sites; SPPN Capital Campaign preliminary preparations; SPPS, and its connection to the parish through each of our church sites.

After all we've been through, first for the past twenty-three years, and then the last four through Growing Disciples, you'd have thought we're just about "done". But as a matter of fact, our unity (no doubt that it's there, and that it's developing) is still fragile. So...."We've Only Just Begun."

For any of you who won't be able to be at our Masses during my addresses to each of our church sites, there will be copies of the sermons available. Oh! Same thing goes for the Mass Schedule surveys. I like things out in the open. Can't do it all the time - can, this time, though. Fr. T.

**Once-In-A-Lifetime Organ Concert!** We are pleased, and very much honored, to announce that Dr. Paula Pugh Romanau, Ph.D. and D.M.A. in classical organ, will present a concert of 17th and 18th century French organ masterworks on Friday, June 19, 7:00 p.m., at Sts. Peter and Paul Church Site of Holy Archangels Parish, in Nauvoo. This invitation is going out to musicians and members of the various communities of faith in the Tri-State Area. Dr. Romanau "discovered" our Hook Organ upon arrival for an initial practice here and can demonstrate and teach - even "demystify!" - various ornamentation techniques for classical organ repertoire, hymnody, and other church-related accompaniment.

**Once-in-a-Lifetime Organ Workshop!** As if the concert isn't more than enough already, Dr. Romanau invites church organists and liturgical musicians to attend a formal music workshop on Saturday, June 20, beginning at 10 a.m. Musicians will be shown a sampling of the full range of possibilities that the organ provides, and be able to ask questions in order to further benefit from Dr. Romanau's experience and artistry. The fee for the workshop is \$25. Please call 217-525-2518 for more information and to register.

**Corpus Christi Sunday: The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ.** We haven't had an outdoor Eucharistic Procession in a while, and we wait one more year. The schedule for God's Portion Day, and the desire for a procession to take place from all of our church sites, led us to wait on an outdoor procession. But Masses this weekend have concluded with Benediction to highlight the central mystery of our faith: "Behold, I am with you until the end of the age": the proof is right there, in the Monstrance, the Tabernacle, by the red-tinted vigil candle, indicating the Jesus Christ dwells with us in all the tabernacles of the world.

**Healing Service.** The Sacraments of Penance and the Anointing of the Sick, the ministry of Mr. Roger Shaner, and the intercessory prayer to Bishop Fulton Sheen come our way on Saturday, June 20, after the ICC 4:00 p.m. Mass, at 5:15 p.m. The opportunities for graces addressing a multitude of needs are provided here. And if your presence is only to support in prayer those who come in need of various healings, please do support the evening with your prayer.

**Spanish Mass.** Because Fr. Tony will be gone from the afternoon of June 14 through the evening of June 18, **Spanish Mass has been moved to Sunday, June 21, at 5 p.m., at ICC.** Please pass the word on, to make sure people are aware of the change of date!

**Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: Part II.** As long as everyone realizes that a funeral can change plans on Friday, June 12....Along with the 8 a.m. Mass on the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart, we intend to have Holy Hours from 8:30 to 9:30 a.m. at SPPN, Noon to 1 p.m. at ICC, and 5:30 to 6:30 p.m. at SHW. Along with the resources we will be receiving from the Diocese, please look at your schedules, and see whether you can be a part of any of these opportunities on Sacred Heart Day, Friday, June 12.

**Please Pray for our Parish Staff.** Our staff is entitled, "Parish Leadership Team." I call them "The Brother Elias Foundation," in honor of the Franciscan Brother who brought order and detail to the radical, multi-faceted ministry of St. Francis of Assisi. Fr. Tony has been in dire need of a Brother Elias as long as he's been a priest! Whatever the title: offer a prayer for our leadership team on Monday, June 8. They will be participating in a Strategic Plan, leading to a commitment to reach desired goals over a three-year period, with an annual look toward the on-going third year. I'd put them up against any staff in the diocese, and come out on top: can't imagine where we'd be without them. "As you have done, so continue to do," says St. Paul to the Thessalonians. Keep us in prayer. Fr. T.
