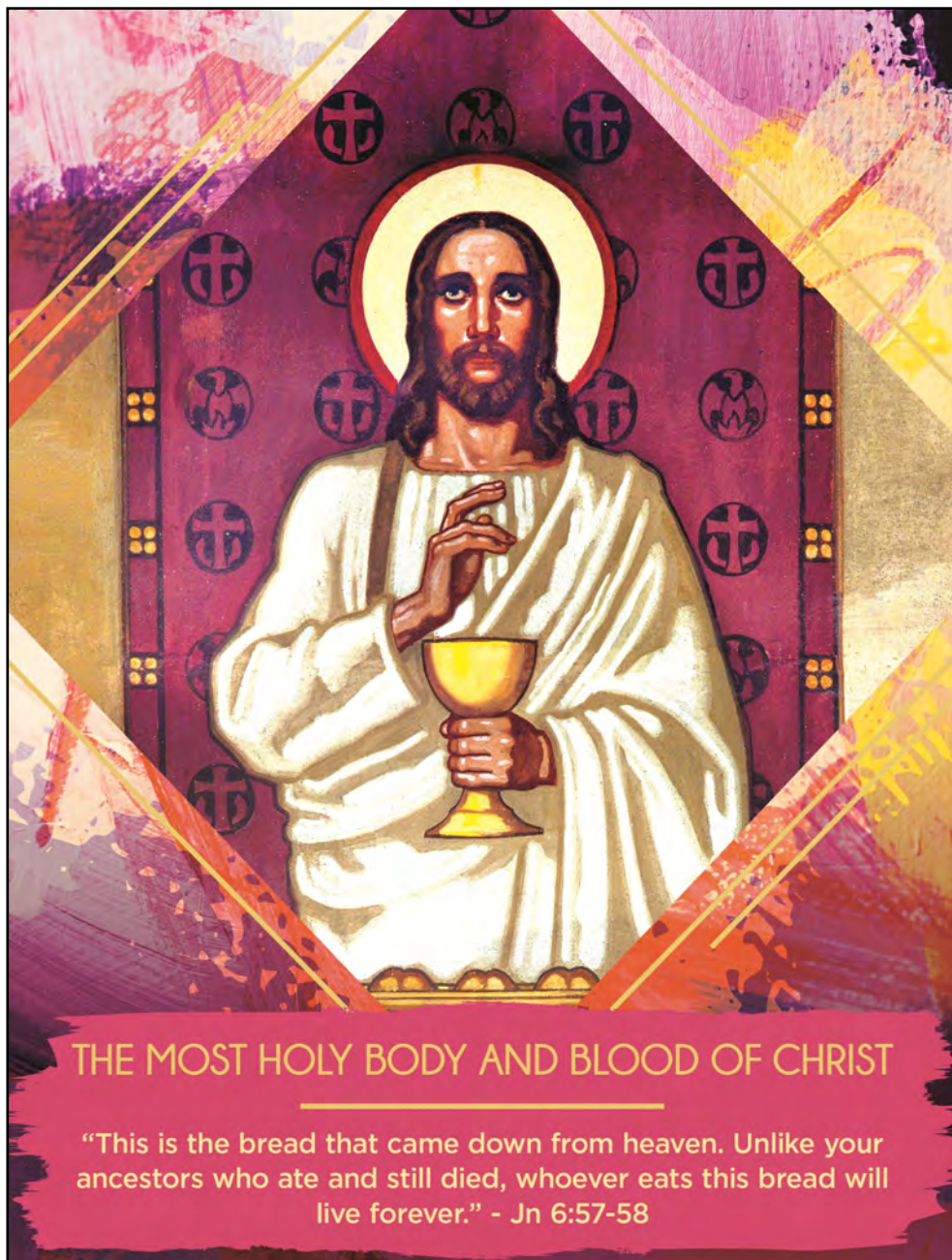

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on the first Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith, be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent (s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the parish office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled AFTER meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

Forget Me Not Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

Dt 8:2-3, 14b-16a / Ps 147:12-13, 14-15, 19-20 / 1 Cor 10:16-17 / Jn 6:51-58

There are several legends attributed to the “Forget Me Not” flower. One such legend suggests, after God had named all the flowers, one flower called out “forget me not!” God responded, “that shall be your name.” Obviously, God does not forget, but humanity has a pretty good history of forgetting about God! In today's first reading, Moses reminds the Israelites of God's presence throughout their journey on their way to the promised land despite discomforts and extended periods of dryness.
