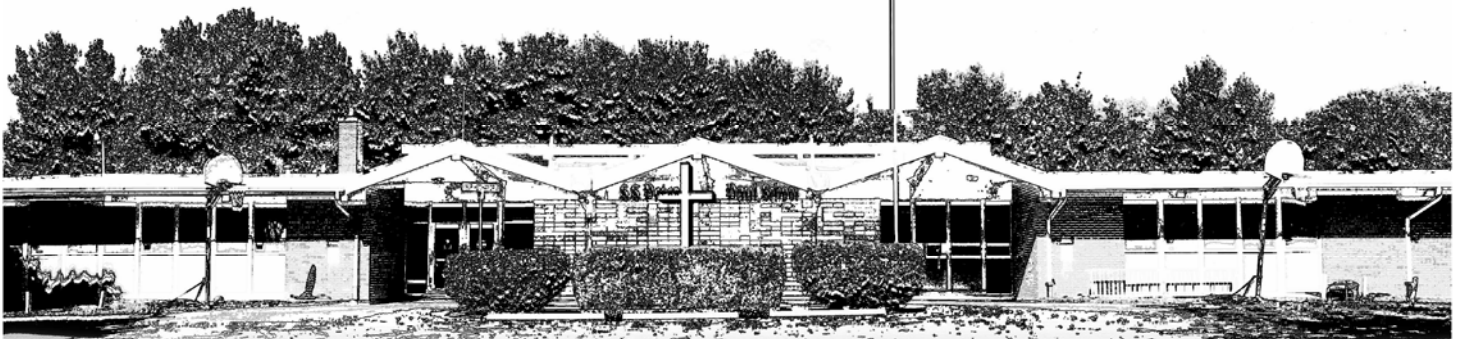

Home Masses Around the County

With the closing of our West Point (Illinois), Dallas City, and Hamilton churches, we look ahead to discern how we are going to maintain a Catholic presence throughout Hancock County where there are no Catholic Churches. With the presence of a church in any given area, you have a specific location where people can be met, meetings can be held, appointments can be kept, and community gatherings can be held. The specific location of a church "tells" you, "You have to show up; you have to be there." Locations are anchors and reminders of the need for ministry.

We don't have church locations anymore in West Point/Bowen/Augusta, Dallas City/Lomax/LaHarpe, and Hamilton. As a result, it becomes "easier" to place priorities on existing church sites, at the expense of paying attention to people in these other locations. Especially for those who find travel difficult, or who want to have some contact with other Catholics with whom they celebrated faith in a church once upon a time, we need to make a commitment to a presence - not just in three places, but throughout the county.

In this bulletin, you will read about two Masses to be celebrated in homes of parishioners willing to serve as host for the celebration of the Eucharist. These gatherings will include fellowship time afterward. There will also be opportunity for confession and for the Anointing of the Sick, for those who want to make sure they've received the sacred Anointing in the event that a priest would not be available in a future emergency.

We'll continue to try to do our best in making present the Catholic faith. Attempts might be faltering ones and might not be successful all the time. But...we're going to try. Fr. T.

On Tuesday, July 21, we will have a home Mass at the home of Tim and Jamie Farniok, 1869 E. County Road 3000, Dallas City. The order of events is the same as that which you just read above. For Hamilton or Dallas City Catholics - or for anyone who, as a part of the parish, wants to be a part of these Masses as well - you can call, text, or email Fr.
