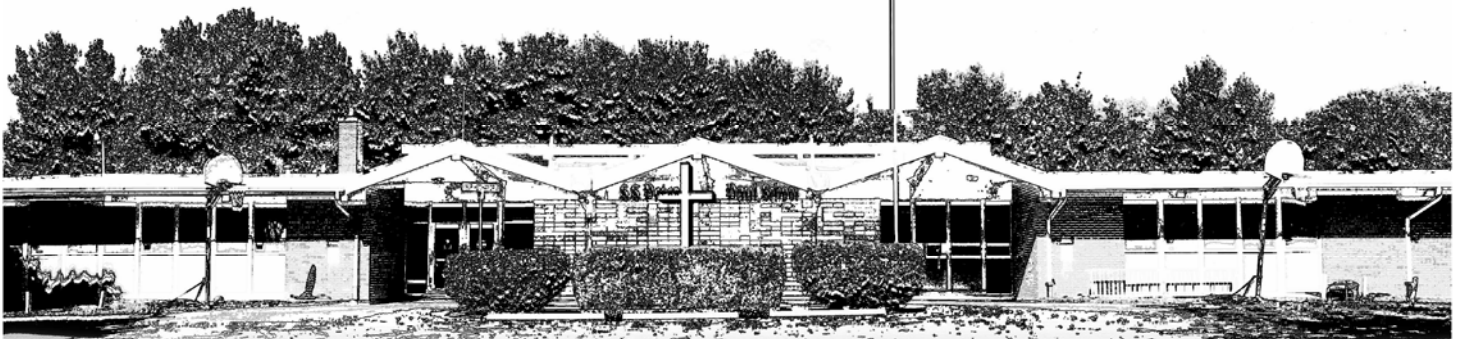

Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

"Heart," as is pretty well known by now, means the deepest identity, the deepest meaning, the very ground and core of your being, in the Bible. Therefore, there's a lot that follows from the Sacred Heart of Jesus. For one thing, at the very essence of Jesus is the union of his human (body and soul, with a human mind and will) and divine (the Eternal Word of God the Father, with a divine mind and will, one with the Father) natures - *as one person!* But at his essence, Jesus is forever united and present to the Father and the Son: Three Persons in One God. Therefore, Jesus cannot be separated from the Father and the Holy Spirit. Think about other religions that claim and practice a deep love and devotion to Jesus, but do not believe the real communion of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit: that, in effect, the Three Persons are separate gods. Now imagine someone telling you that shouldn't make a difference, because of the devotion and love of Jesus we apparently share. But wait: if you love Jesus at his very essence, you have to love the Father and the Holy Spirit in eternal communion with him. No matter how things look, that's a big difference, at the very essence - the "Sacred Heart" - of things. Right?

Another thing following from the Sacred Heart of Jesus: here comes Mary, his Mother. The Holy Trinity is characterized by "missions" and "processions". The mission of the Father is to create and sustain; the mission of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is to redeem; the mission of the Holy Spirit is to sanctify, to make holy. The Son eternally "proceeds" from the Father; the Holy Spirit eternally "proceeds" from the Father and the Son. There is no greater privilege and responsibility than to say "yes" to the divine invitation to have the Three Persons of the Blessed Trinity fulfill

Continued...its missions and processions *through us!* Nobody did that in a more intimate, primal, body-and-soul way than Mary! And if she's the way that the Sacred Heart of Jesus chose to come into the world, then his holiness would have to redeem her entire life, *in prelude to her life!* And since she lived her life in history, her entire life had to be filled with that redemption, all the way back to her conception.

Looks like we have an Immaculate Conception and an Immaculate Heart of Mary, here!

Beyond the "look" of things, where there seems to be so much "in common" - let's make it a point to know and understand our faith...*and* treasure what we have in common. Fr. T.
