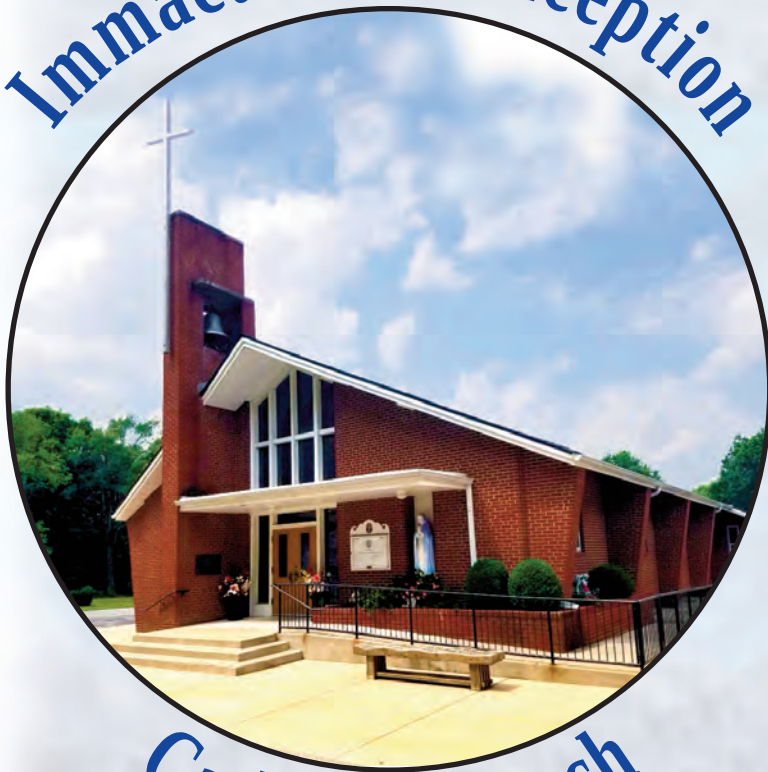

What does it mean to be human in the age of AI? A presentation by MSGR. Swetland

All are welcome for an evening with Msgr. Stuart Swetland as he unpacks Pope Leo XIV's landmark first encyclical, Magnifica Humanitas—On Safeguarding the Human Person in the Time of Artificial Intelligence. The presentation will take place in the St. Michael the Archangel church on August 10 from 7:00 - 8:30 p.m. Signed on May 15, 2026, this historic document calls the Church and all people of good will to engage the promises and dangers of artificial intelligence through the lens of Catholic social teaching and the dignity of the human person. Drawing on Scripture, the tradition of Pope Leo XIII's Rerum Novarum, and the vision of the New Evangelization, Msgr. Swetland will guide us through the key themes of the encyclical and what they mean for our lives, our families, and our world. Msgr. Swetland is the president of Donnelly College and for over 20 years has presented and defended Catholic social teaching through various media outlets.

Statement regarding Kansas elections

The upcoming August vote regarding whether to return the Kansas Supreme Court judicial selection process to a popular vote is a significant decision for our state. While the Church does not take a position on the outcome of this ballot measure, it does encourage all Catholics to embrace their civic responsibility by participating in this important vote, grounding their decision in Catholic principles and a well-formed conscience. I also encourage respectful and charitable dialogue, especially when opinions differ. May our participation in this election be prayerful, guided by the Holy Spirit, rooted in the dignity of every human person, and a witness to the love of Christ.

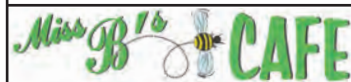

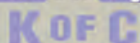
