BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on the first Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith, be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent (s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the parish office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled AFTER meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

Cradle of Catholicism in the Diocese of Wichita Pilgrimage

The Office of Respect Life & Social Justice and Catholic Senior Adult Ministries invite you to join the **Cradle of Catholicism in the Diocese of Wichita Pilgrimage on Monday, September 21, 2026.** This one-day trip will explore the historic Catholic mission sites of southeast Kansas, including **St. Patrick Church (Chanute)**, the ruins of **St. Aloysius Church**, and **St. Francis Hieronymo Church (Osage Mission)** in St. Paul, where the roots of the Diocese of Wichita began. A Steward Shares

“If you lend money to those from whom you expect repayment, what credit is that to you? Even sinners lend to sinners and get back the same amount”. (Lk 6:34).

What has been received must now be shared. Stewardship is to discipleship what exercise is to a gym membership. Membership alone does not mean one is exercising; so too, being a disciple does not necessarily mean one is living as a steward. For this reason, stewardship can be called a “spirituality of sharing.” Within this sharing, a double dignity is revealed. The one who gives acknowledges that he or she has something to offer, affirming personal dignity. The one who receives is recognized as worthy of sacrifice, affirming the dignity of the other. Furthermore, this sharing is to be offered without expectation of return, as Jesus teaches in the passage quoted above.

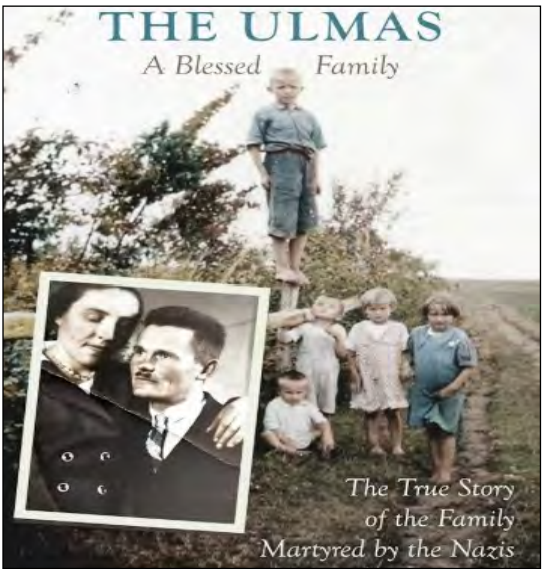
