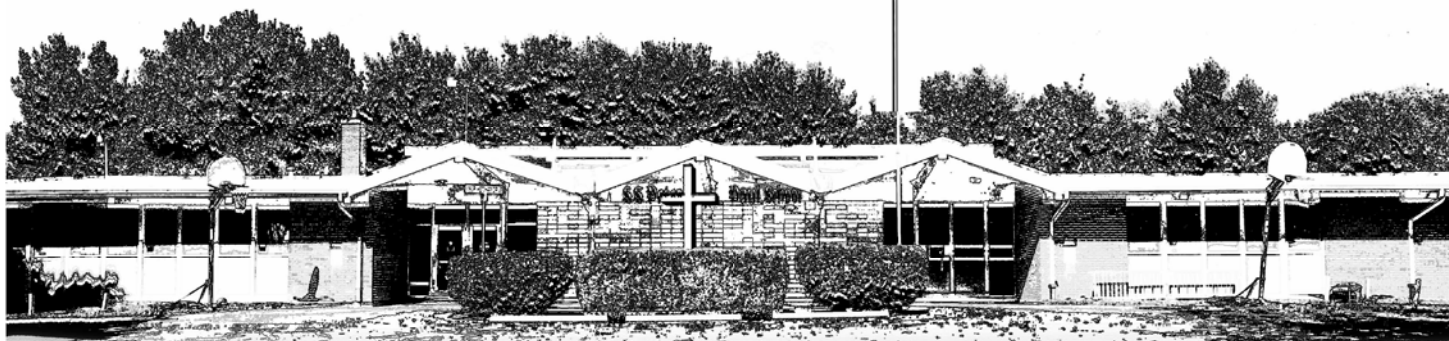

Thank You

Between 1978 and 1985, my first seven years as a priest, it was normal...nothing to think about at all...to have one, maybe two morning Masses, and then appointments at 9, 10, and 11 a.m. The afternoon, depending on the day of the week, would include visits to three hospitals and several nursing homes, either before or after which would be appointments at 1, 2, and 3 p.m., or 3, 4, and 5 p.m. The evening would be filled with appointments at 6, 7, 8, and maybe even 9 p.m. That was the week, for seven years, one personal day a week - unless an emergency took up the personal day. The phone calls continued from 9 a.m. till 10 p.m.; one day, I left to run an errand that took fifteen minutes. Upon my return, eleven phone call messages were waiting for me!

Things resumed in the same fashion, with two assignments interrupting the pattern, but still, pretty much the same from 1988 till 1998. A change in assignment in 1998 introduced me to the world of professional occupations, owners of businesses, university professors, and the like. After 5 p.m., it was a rare thing to have personal one-on-one appointments, except for emergencies. Sick calls, death watches, care for the poor: change in schedule, increase in tension and intensity, because the people I served lived and operated under relentlessly high expectations.

Phone calls dropped dramatically. Phone and email messages increased. And I was never in a position to remain in the rectory and wait for any of it to come. (This isn't just my story, by the way: parish priesthood, plain and simple, whoever the priest is.)

All of that to say this: thank you for your patience when nobody is at the Villa Marie Rectory, our school, or by a phone or computer screen to immediately meet your needs. Everybody's "on the go" here; it's the only way this whole thing works. Don't be shy! Be persistent! We're all trying - no slacking off in these here parts! And once again: thanks for your patience. Home Masses Update Our gratitude and appreciation goes out to Jim Layfield, and to Tim and Jamie Farniok, for the Home Masses and get-togethers the past two Tuesday evenings. We are considering a Home Mass schedule akin to the Nursing Home schedule we used to have throughout the county: for examples, each Wednesday would have a home Mass in the Hamilton, Dallas City, and Bowen/Augusta/West Point areas. Again: for people who might not be able to have a priest available for emergency needs, these events could be a huge help. Opportunity for Confession and Apostolic Pardon, Anointing of the Sick, and Mass - perhaps in concert with pastoral care home visits in the designated area - provide assurance and security that essential spiritual needs are being met, especially for people for whom travel is difficult. We'll be working on this in the months ahead.
