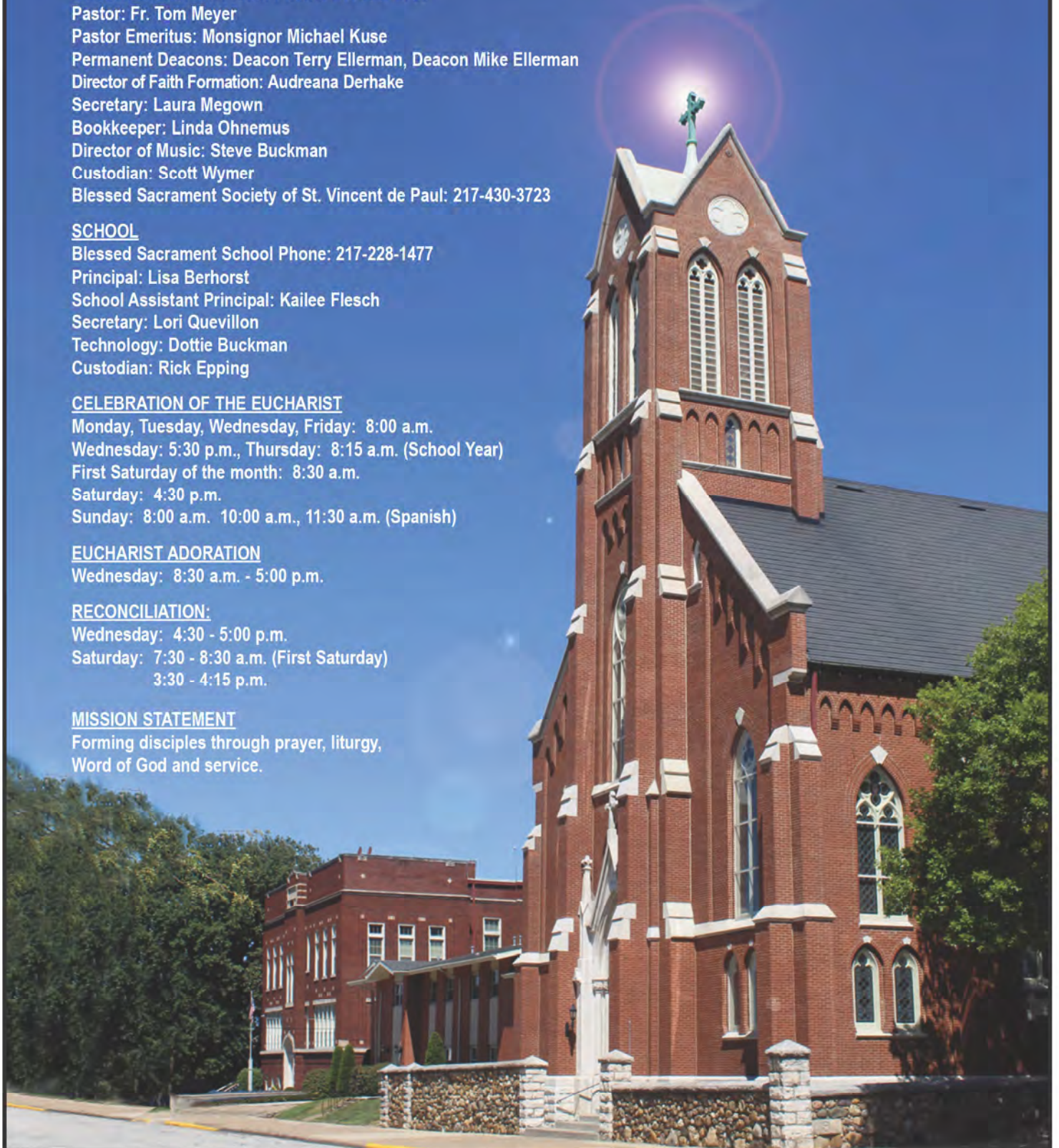

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate **14th Sunday of Ordinary Time**. Our 1st Reading is from the Book of the Prophet Zechariah. The reading is speaking about the arrival of the newly anointed King Solomon into Jerusalem. He is riding on his father David's animal, a donkey. By arriving on such a simple and humble animal, Solomon is making a statement about his coming kingly reign which will be peaceful. Solomon will banish the weapons of war – chariot, horse, and warrior's bow. Solomon will unite the northern and southern tribes of Israel (Ephraim and Jerusalem), and will proclaim peace to the nations. His dominion will be "from sea to sea."

Historically we know that King Solomon's united kingdom did not last, but splintered into two upon his death. Solomon therefore could not have been the ultimate fulfillment of this prophetic oracle. Rather, a future son of David will fulfill this vision of a Kingdom of unity and peace.

In the Palm Sunday entrance Gospel, Jesus shows that He fulfills this passage by prophetically riding into Jerusalem on a donkey. He is the promised son of David who rides into Jerusalem to proclaim a Kingdom of peace and unite all the nations to himself. He is the Son of David, and in today's Gospel He affirms that He is the Son of God. "All things have been handed over to me by my Father. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son wishes to reveal him."

We therefore are living now in a new era of peace and humility called the Kingdom of God. Although wars and violence continue to persist, the promised Son of David continues to reign among us. If we look closely we will see Him today, "meek and riding on an ass." Try to find Him among us, who is "meek and humble of heart".

This upcoming **Tue. July 7th at 6:00pm** is our monthly **Theology on Tap** discussion at the Fuzzy Bubbler. Fr. Tom Szydlak from the Diocese of Peoria will be speaking. Please come join us for good spiritual food and fun with other members of our faith in our Quincy community.

I continue to promote a **9-Day Pilgrimage to Rome and Assisi scheduled for next May 3-11, 2027**. I will be the Spiritual Director for this pilgrimage, and the Catholic tour company we will be utilizing is 206 Tours. The cost for the pilgrimage is \$6,247 per person. Finally, during the 4 weeks of June 27th - July 24th I have registered for classes at the **Institute for Liturgical Formation at Christendom College in Front Royal, Virginia**. During my absence **Fr. Troy Niemerg** (Ordained 2024) of Quincy University will cover the daily and weekend Masses from July 1-17. Cross Catholic Outreach will be sending Fr. Jude to cover on the weekend of July 18-19. I thank you all for this opportunity of formation and study away from the parish.
