From the Pastor's Desk

Today the Church celebrates the **18th Sunday in Ordinary Time**. In the Gospel Jesus receives news that John the Baptist has been executed in prison. He withdraws by boat to go to a deserted place, but the crowds follow him. His heart is moved with pity and he cures their sick. He recognizes their hunger and inability to obtain food, and so works the miracle of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes. Matthew uses very intentional language in describing Jesus' actions: "he said the blessing, broke the loaves, and gave them to the disciples." Jesus will use these exact same words later with his disciples at the Last Supper as He feeds them with His Body and Blood. Jesus' miracle of the Feeding of the Five Thousand is therefore highly Eucharistic in character. Jesus wishes to feed His people with the Eucharist today, anticipating the eternal banquet He will feed us in Heaven. I find it fascinating how quickly Jesus moves to the Eucharist as He foresees, through the death of his cousin John, that His death may be approaching.

Finally, this upcoming **Tue. Aug. 4th at 6:00pm** is our monthly **Theology on Tap** discussion at the Fuzzy Bubbler. This month Fr. Steve Arisman from St. Francis will be giving us an update talk on the **Future Shrine for Fr. Augustus Tolton**. Please come join us for good spiritual food and a fun time with other members of faith in our Quincy community.

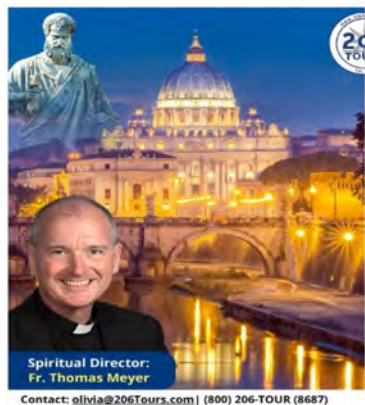
