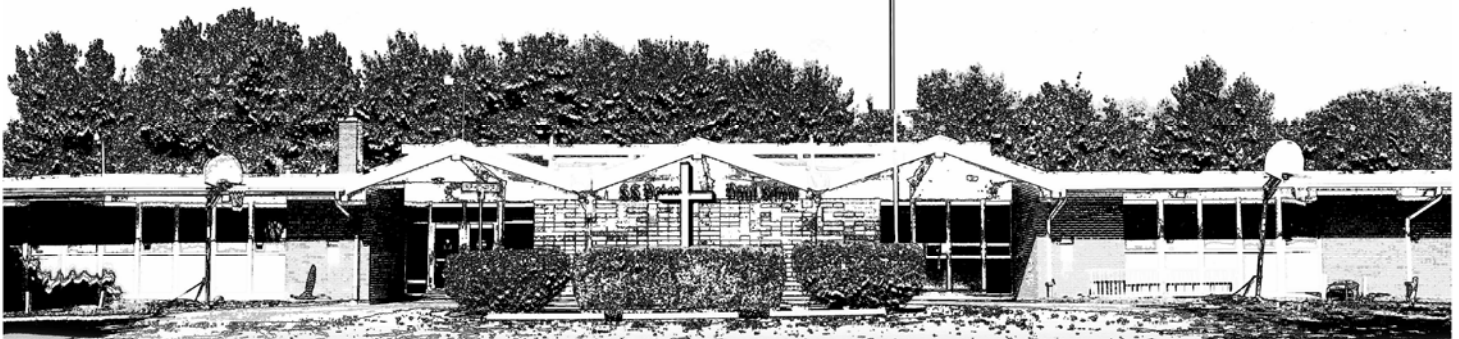

Thanking God for the Parents God Gave You

I remember their words as I flew out the front or back door of my boyhood home: the relentless reminder coming from my parents. "When you're playing ball in the street, don't let the ball go into peoples' yards." "Stay out of the Gerdimans' back yard when you go to the field: there's the alley behind our back yard, and the sidewalk out in front." "You boys keep out of Mr. Doak's back yard when you're playing flashlight tag." "I don't care if Dwight says it's OK; stay out of Mr. and Mrs. Benner's back yard." There was this priority about respecting the neighbors' property: "Don't ever take permission for granted: ask first. And we're telling you, 'Don't even ask.' Just stay out of the neighbors' yards." Even in house, between my brothers and me: "If it isn't yours, hands off. If you want to use it or play with it, ask first. If you get 'no' for an answer, then hands off - it isn't yours. Your mother and I will talk to each of you about being willing to share. But be willing to respect your brothers' property." I still remember every word coming from Mom and Dad.

Which is why I'm amazed to see a number of adults having absolutely no problem with using our yard by St. Joseph House to make their way to the new Temple Visitors Center from the Temple Fitting Room on Knight Street, or the other way around. Throw in the shortcuts taken through our school property, especially during the school year. In the shoes of the trespassers, it wouldn't occur to me to take shortcuts through other peoples' property. We have sidewalks to use for wherever we're going on Young, Knight, and Wells Street. With any kind of upbringing that reminds you that the world doesn't revolve around *you*, it's just something you don't do. But evidently, not everybody

Continued... got - or gets - the same message at home. Just go with "the way I see things according to me," and go ahead: do whatever you want. What? Bother asking first? Why?

Some of these people raise kids: more of the same, coming. Lucky us. And here it comes: "no big deal...mountain out of a molehill...what's my problem...so sorry to bother your grass...go ahead, it's not hurting anything...." There's a name back at home for anybody with these kinds of comebacks: Dwight. Go back and check out what my parents said about Dwight, above. Respect property. Stay out of peoples' yards. Fr. T.
