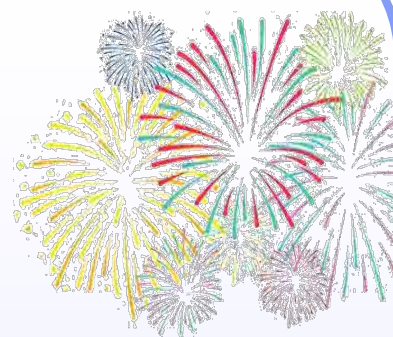
CCW'S BLAST!!!!

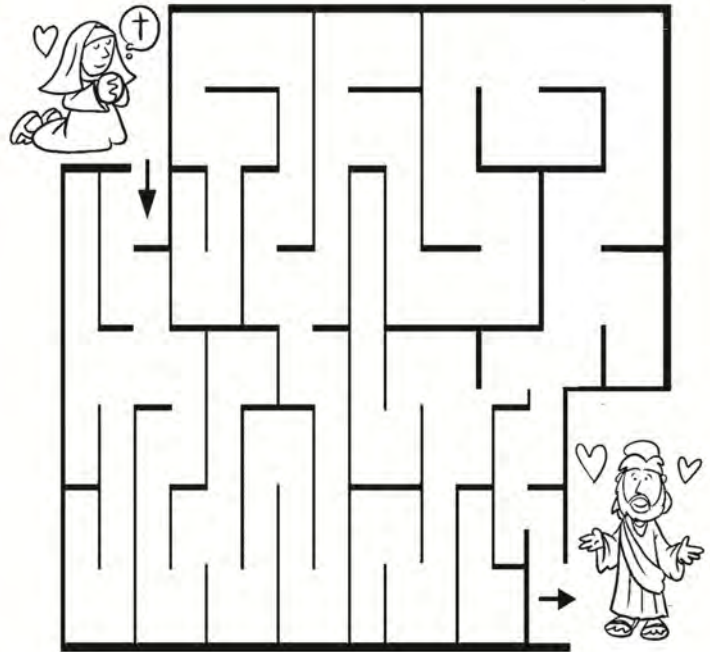

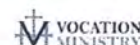

Prayer for Priests

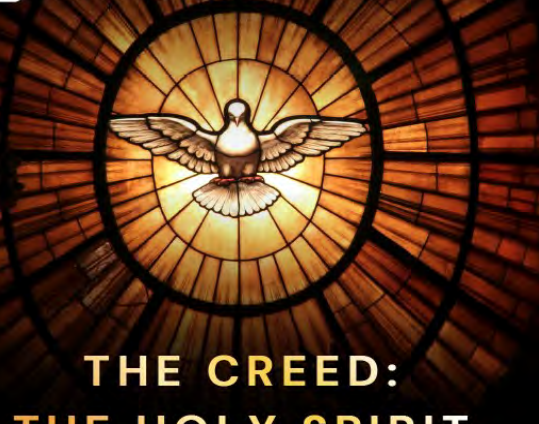
