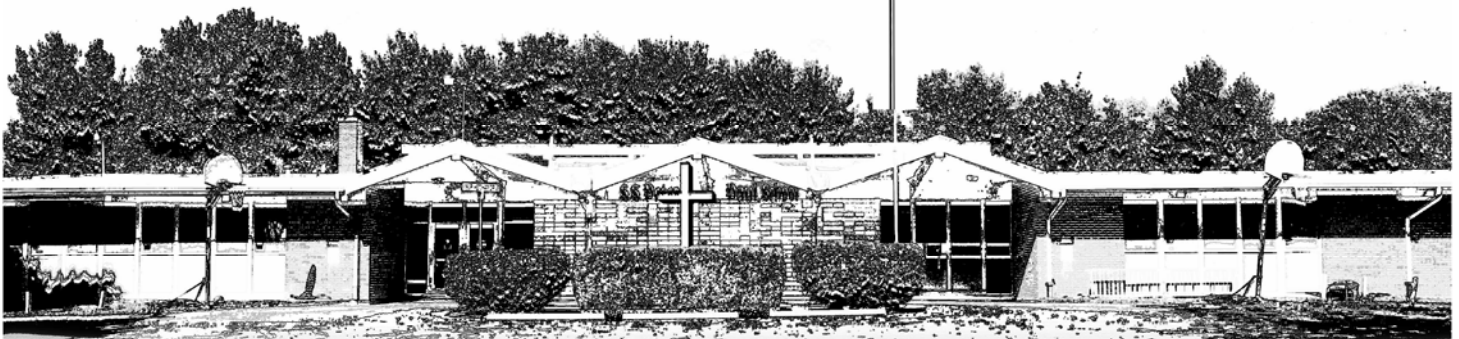

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, August 15

Although it was determined not to be a Holy Day of Obligation this year (I know, I know: I wonder about that one, too), it wouldn't be a bad idea to review Catholic teaching about Mary. We begin with eternity: from the depths of the Holy Trinity, Mary was in the mind of God before and beyond time. Eternally, she was already a servant of the plan of salvation. She was conceived without Original Sin, because, as the New Eve, God restored the fact that, in the original plan of creation, to *not* sin is only human. Besides, the procession and mission of the Son from the Father, and the Holy Spirit from the Father and the Son, from all eternity, would mean her freedom from sin, from the beginning of her life - and even in the 21st century, that means *from conception*. Don't forget: this plan rested in total, eternal purity, before Mary was conceived. At the deepest, most penetrating part of her being, the deepest recesses of her humanity - what is meant in the Bible by her Heart - there is no trace of sin. Her Son and her God, Jesus, saved her from the Cross, *in anticipation* of the mystery of the Cross in history. With no sin, there is no reason for the separation of the body from the soul. Therefore, without a definitive determination whether she entered into death, and taking into account her free will from all eternity, Mary is brought into the eternal love of the Holy Trinity, glorified body and soul. Hers, as a creature, was the gift given to her by her Son, whose glorified body and soul is his prerogative as God - and ours, as creatures, at the end of time. The whole point of the Assumption is that "our turn" is definitely coming!
