BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on the first Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith, be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent (s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the parish office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled AFTER meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

FROM FATHER H

Upcoming Adult Formation - I will be presenting two upcoming adult formation opportunities.

The first will be for the women of our parish. It will be a two-part class presenting an overview of the Women in the Bible, and their spirituality as members of a faith community. The first class will take place on **Monday, September 21 at 6:00 p.m.** and will discuss the women of the Old Testament. The second class will take place on **Monday, December 14** and will discuss the women of the New Testament with an emphasis on the Gospel of Luke. Both sessions will run two hours in length: the first hour will be presentation and the second hour will be group discussions related to present day women's spirituality.

The second formation opportunity will be during the season of Lent. It will be an in-depth study of the Passion Narrative of Mark through Biblical exegesis. It will take place on six consecutive Monday nights beginning on **February 8, 2027** and concluding on **March 15, 2027**.

There are no costs for either of these formation opportunities and materials will be provided for both.

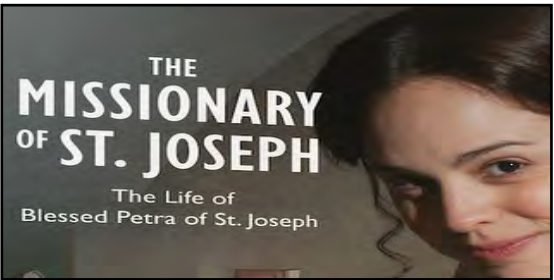
