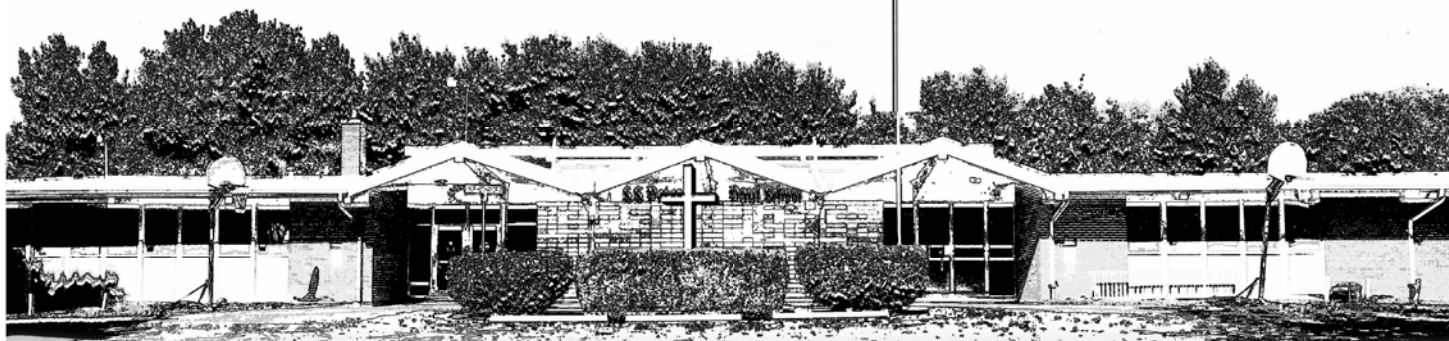

Proclaiming Christ, Yesterday, Today, and Forever: The Annual Diocesan Appeal.

I begin by recommending to you a video on our diocesan website about our Annual Diocesan Appeal, taking place next weekend. Go to www.cdop.org/ada, please! You will hear a recently deceased priest, having lived ninety years, over fifty of them in active priestly ministry, speak about the need to support vocations to the priesthood. His answer to a question about his preferred legacy? "I hope I was a faithful priest." You will see the fantastic marriage preparation retreat now provided by the Diocese of Peoria for Engaged Couples. As you watch gift Bibles being received by the couples, you'll hear the following words: "God has to be the center of your marriage." And you'll see young children taking part in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, a 'hands on' learning about our faith, in an intentionally structured space. The kids will tell you all about it!

Personally, I am gratified to see concrete results showing up in the pastoral efforts of our diocese. Last Saturday, The Office of Mission Support of our diocese came to Monmouth and presented a simple, concrete, practical way of actually doing evangelization among family and friends. First: hey, they came our way! Second: anyone, young or old, would have learned how to enter into talking about Jesus to others, in a way that isn't awkward or threatening. I wish more people would have come.

After the change we've experienced in envisioning ourselves as a parish - and even considering our losses through the process - the Diocese of Peoria needs our support for programs that are actually reaching people and actually showing results. Let's be a part of the Church beyond the boundaries of our parish and offer prayer to discover what our Lord would like for us to do to support the cause of *Proclaiming Christ, Yesterday, Today, and Forever.* Fr.
