Tuition Fees will remain the same as last year

- ✦ \$325 for 1 student
- ✦ \$350 for two students
- ✦ \$375 for 3 or more students.

Tuition is due in September when REP sessions start unless you call Michelle to set up a payment plan.

Call the Parish Office if you missed the REP registration deadline this weekend.

For the 2026 - 2027 REP year, our class sessions have two changes worth noting.

Our Tuesday evening sessions will be at Ascension of Our Lord, Oakbrook Terrace campus on Summit from 6:30 p.m. - 7:45 p.m.

It is a change from last year's Wednesday evenings.

Our Sunday morning sessions will be at Christ the King campus in the Faith Formation building 9:30 a.m. - 10:45 a.m. So, Families may attend 11:00 a.m. Mass together!

There are not any evening weekday REP sessions at Christ the King Faith Formation building.

 - ✦ See link to register online below or use the attachment to print and complete registration and drop off at the Parish Office
 - ✦ The start time for REP has been changed this year
 - ✦ Sunday session time is 9:30 a.m. - 10:45 a.m. at Christ the King Formation Center (previous parish school building)
 - . So, families can attend Mass immediately after REP
 - . Tuesday sessions is 6:30 p.m. - 7:45 p.m.
 - . There are three changes:
 - . No longer a Wednesday evening option
 - . Tuesday sessions are being held at Ascension of Our Lord campus
 - . The start time of class has been pushed back 30 minutes
- This is to elevate families having to rush to get to REP on time and students disrupting the sessions already started by coming in late.

It is important to register at your earliest convenience, so we do not have any issues with needing to make second orders of workbooks or supplies. It is extremely important to also include Baptism and if applies First Communion Certificates or just dates of Sacraments, if they were at Ascension of Our Lord or Christ the King Parish.

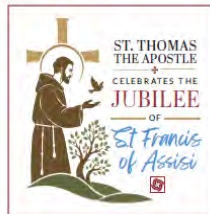
