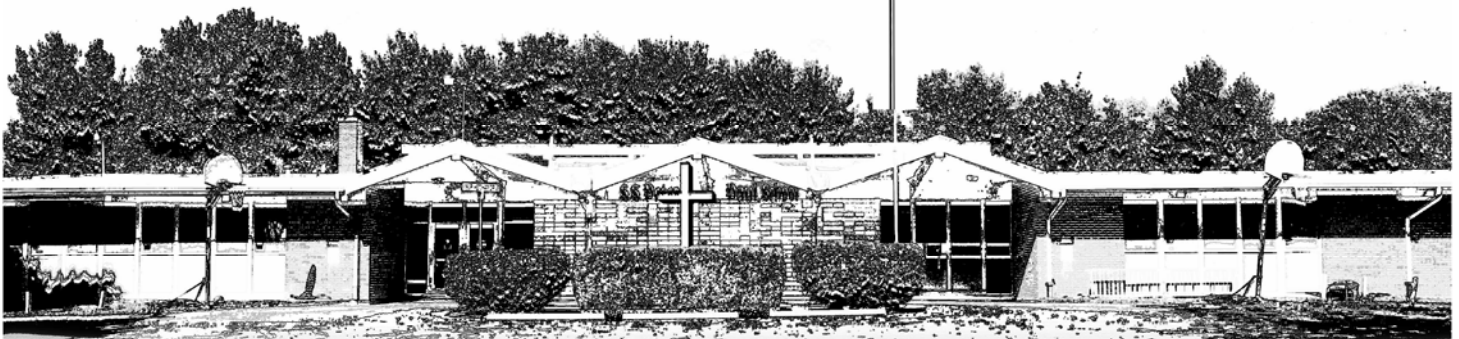

Proclaiming Christ, Yesterday, Today, and Forever: Part II. Blessed Fulton Sheen

I want you to imagine a German family in the early 1930's, leaving their mother country and setting course for citizenship in the United States of America. The father of the family sees what's coming in Germany: the National Socialist Party led by Adolph Hitler hasn't won elections, but there's something about adherents to Socialism that began to stand out to him. Political victories would indeed be victories to them; but political losses were mere temporary truces. They were not defeats. They just keep coming. And Germany in this period is not vigilant. Time to "get out while the getting's good", unlike many who stayed.

Stuck in the miserable excuse that passes for politics in our country, the deplorable "gotcha" news and commentary, and the incredible blindness now called education in the area of political philosophy, Socialism leading to Communism sneaks its way into the nation's life, taking advantage of the current Tower of Babel. During the 1930's, somebody saw, in our country, the same thing Germany saw in its life: Fulton Sheen. His books, writings, and television shows directly confronted Socialism and Communism - on the basis of the flaws in their philosophical systems. And he did it with Catholic social teaching. He knew that both systems had to neutralize and defeat Catholicism - if persecution didn't work, infiltration would. Let the reader understand - especially after watching and listening to some of those inane political ads.

One of the things we have to understand nowadays is that our Church - our Diocese - has to come through with the fulfillment of her mission: has to. Diocesan programs for vocations of priesthood/diaconate and marriage, education and formation, health and pastoral care, and the needs of the poor can't fail now. Bishop Sheen knew that the Sacred Heart of Jesus through the Immaculate Heart of Mary is behind Catholic life and teaching. In the same way that our parish school's necessity includes the challenge to some of the things going on and taught in public education, so it is that our ADA's success advances our church's stand against forces that would prefer her abolition. Live in a larger sense, folks: please give generously to the ADA. Fr. T.
